

STRAUS SPEAKS AT SAVANNAH

Secretary of Commerce and Labor Addresses Board of Trade. TOPIC, "OUR COMMERCIAL AGE"

Development of the South, Rectifying Revenue and Labor and Immigration Problems Discussed.

SAVANNAH, Ga., April 4.—The feature of the celebration of the twenty-fifth anniversary of the Savannah Board of Trade, celebrated here yesterday, was a largely attended banquet tonight at which Secretary Oscar S. Straus, of the Department of Commerce and Labor was a guest and speaker.

"Our Commercial Age," was the subject of Secretary Straus, who said in part: Georgia's Foundation Philanthropic. Georgia was founded in a military age, and in a colony in ancient or in modern times had a nobler beginning or a more philanthropic founder than the colony of Georgia.

Commerce and Neutrality. The classes engaged in industry and commerce, said the great historian Lecky, have been the steady supporters of European unity. Yes, commerce in its modern development is based upon neutrality, and every ship that carries the products of European industry is a messenger of peace and good will.

Commercial Development of South. The commercial development of the south as distinguished from the production of agricultural staples, is of comparatively recent growth, and for that reason all the more remarkable. Let me cite a few examples. Since 1850 the railways of the south have grown to 12,000 to 63,000 miles; in other words, they have practically quadrupled in length.

Reciprocity in Trade. Commerce is reciprocal, and the ships that go to the south and Central American markets to carry the products that the people of those countries sell to us. All of the great maritime powers of the world, whether their economic policy is free trade or protection, create and maintain fair freight and fair shipping rates to their foreign markets by means of liberal postal payments.
