

New Bodices Out of Old

THE display of accessories intended for the ornamenting of the bodices is unusually large and varied this spring...

They are delectable little affairs, these ready to wear waistcoats, much more attractive, many of them, than anything in the same line which an ordinary tailor or dressmaker would be likely to achieve...

One sees comparatively few of the dainty boleros once so popular among lace and embroidery novelties of this class...

Dressmakers returning from abroad brought back such waistcoats for separate sale or for use in costumes of their own making...



There are, too, many arrangements of embroidered lingerie and lace, embroidered net, etc., which are draped in folds from shoulder to waist line...

These overbodices or garnitures are adjusted over simple sheer blouses, and similar crosses 'twixt pelerine and coatee are offered in taffeta embroidered handsomely in silks or in soutache.

Such embroidered net garnitures as the one sketched here, with bold embroidery design in high relief and exquisite colorings, furnish superb trimming for a bodice otherwise simple.

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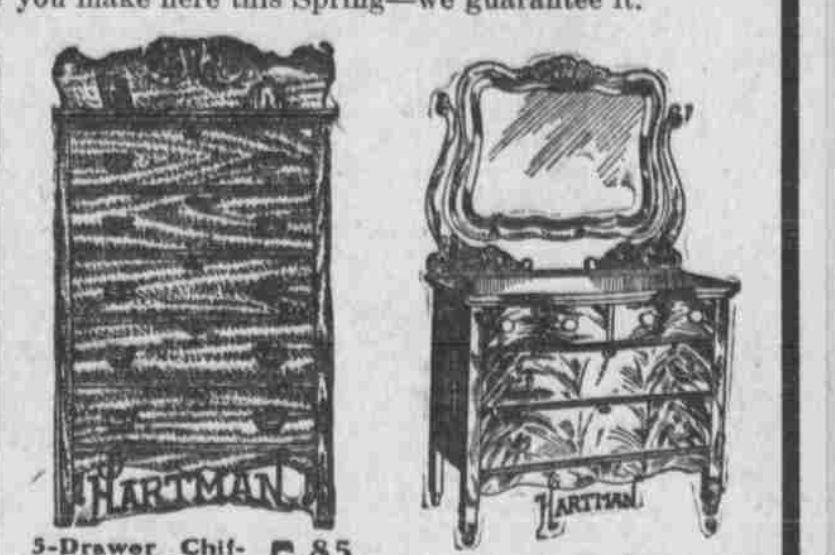
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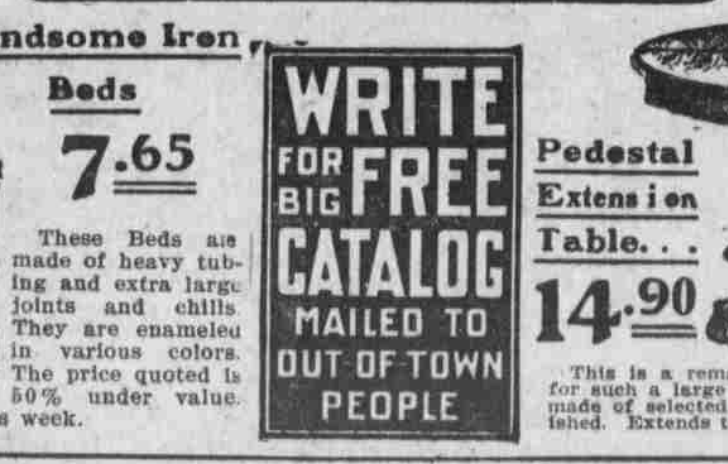


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Allwin 5.65. This is the famous Allwin Go-Cart, the lightest and strongest collapsible cart made.
