#### HOSTESS HOUSE NOW READY OF OCCUPANCY

Camp Gordon, Ga., Sept. 27.-The hostess house for the Colored troops at Camp Gordon, which has been in process of erection for several weeks, is now ready for occupancy. The Atlanta Constitution says: "The house is a building complete in its expression of beauty and comfort, the same attention being given to the details of harmonious and artistic equipment that characterizes all the hostess houses that have been and are still being erected at nearly every cantonment in the country, and is designed along the same lines of the hostess houses for white soldiers." The structure was provided through the efforts of the national war work council of the Y. W. C. A., the headquarters of which is in New York City. This fills a long felt want, as there was great need for the Colored soldiers at Camp Gordon to have a suitable place where they might meet their relatives and friends who had come from a distance to visit them.
