The effect of this judgment means that the Crown holds the dominion of the land, subject to certain rights of the Chartered Company. While this judgment brings little to the native, yet it is essentially a victory in which the native shares, for it protects these lands from passing into the possession of the Chartered Company. Should the Crown, at any time, desire to restore to the native his right of title in the lands, there will be no legal restraints to the carrying out of the wish. It appears that many disinterested persons in England took up the fight and interested themselves in securing judgment that would favor the natives.
