In the matter of the assessment of the Combination Bridge company, after hearing the evidence of the several witnesses, including its officers, and statements showing the net earnings and expenses for the last few years.

Whereas, it is necessary to a just and proper equalization of the assessment of the personal property of the various precincts in Dakota county, and that each precinct will bear just relation to the other precincts of the county, therefore be it

Resolved, by the board of equalization of Dakota county, Nebraska, that there be a raise in Omaha precinct of 10% on horses and 20% on cattle; in Emerson precinct a raise of 9% on horses; in Dakota precinct a reduction of 9% on horses; in Covington precinct a reduction of 15% on cattle; in St John's precinct a reduction of 10% on horses.
