



#### BAKING POWDER MORE WHOLESOME THAN ALUM POWDERS.

Washington, D. C .- Alum baking powders are no more harmful to a person than any other baking powders. Such is the conclusion of the referee board of consulting scientific experts of the department of agriculture as the result of experiments to determine the influence of aluminum compounds on the nutrition and health of man. The report gives the results of three sets of extensive experiments on human subjects conducted independently by members of the board and was in response to questions put to it by the department of agriculture. The board's report was unanimous and was signed by Ira Remsen, president of Johns Hopkins university, Chairman: Russell H. Crittendon, professor of physiological chemistry in Yale university and director of the Sheffield Scientific school: John H. Long, professor of chemistry in Northwestern university; Alonzo E. Taylor, professor or physiological chemistry in the University of Pennsylvania, and Theobala Smith, professor of comparative pathology in Harvard.


