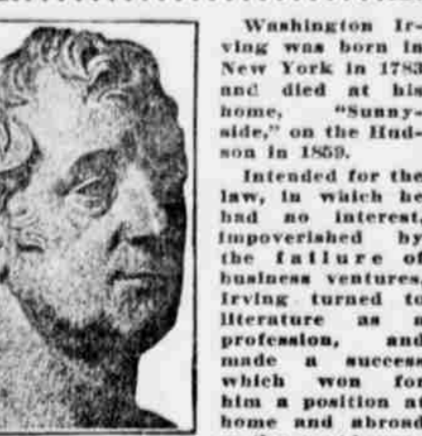

Washington Irving was born in New York in 1783 and died at his home, "Sunny-side," on the Hudson in 1859.

It is true that several years later an old farmer, returning from New York, brought news that Ichabod was still alive.

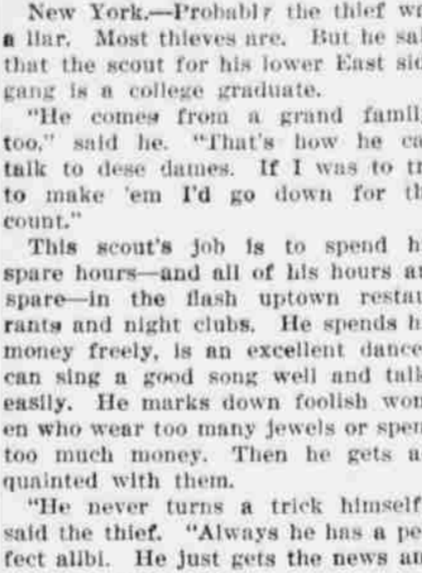

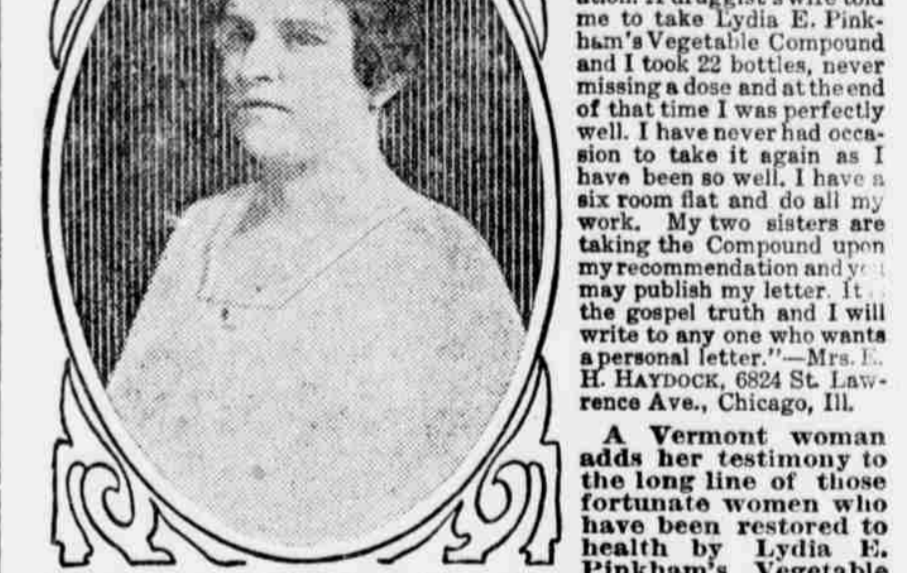
