

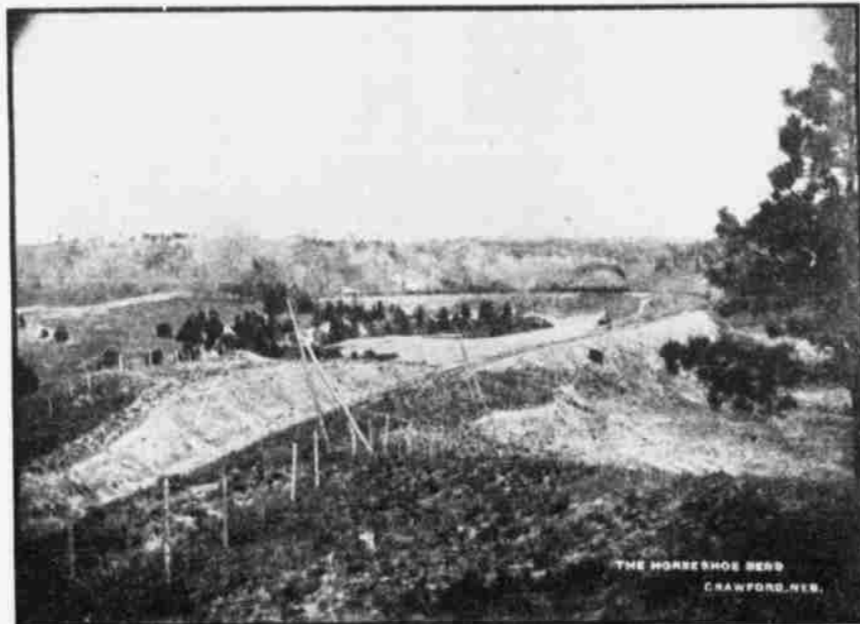

Alliance After the Fire, August 7, 1892.



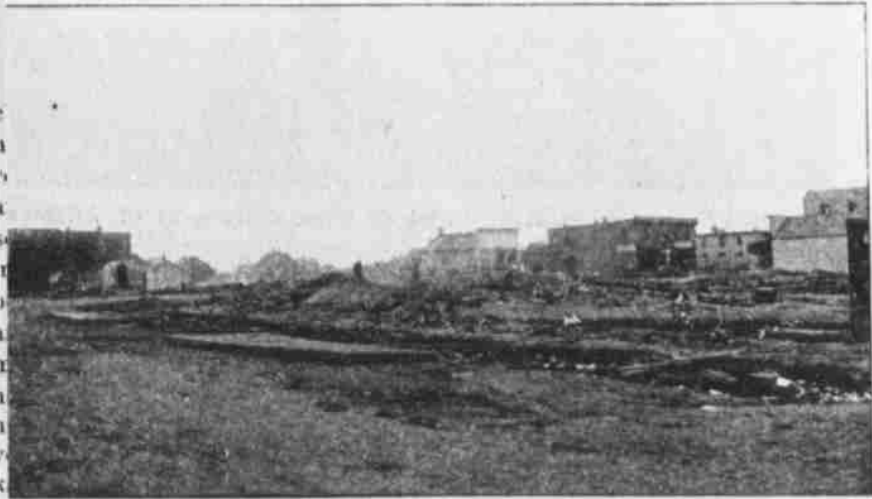
Horseshoe Bend—on B. & M. R. R. 50 Miles Northwest of Alliance.


