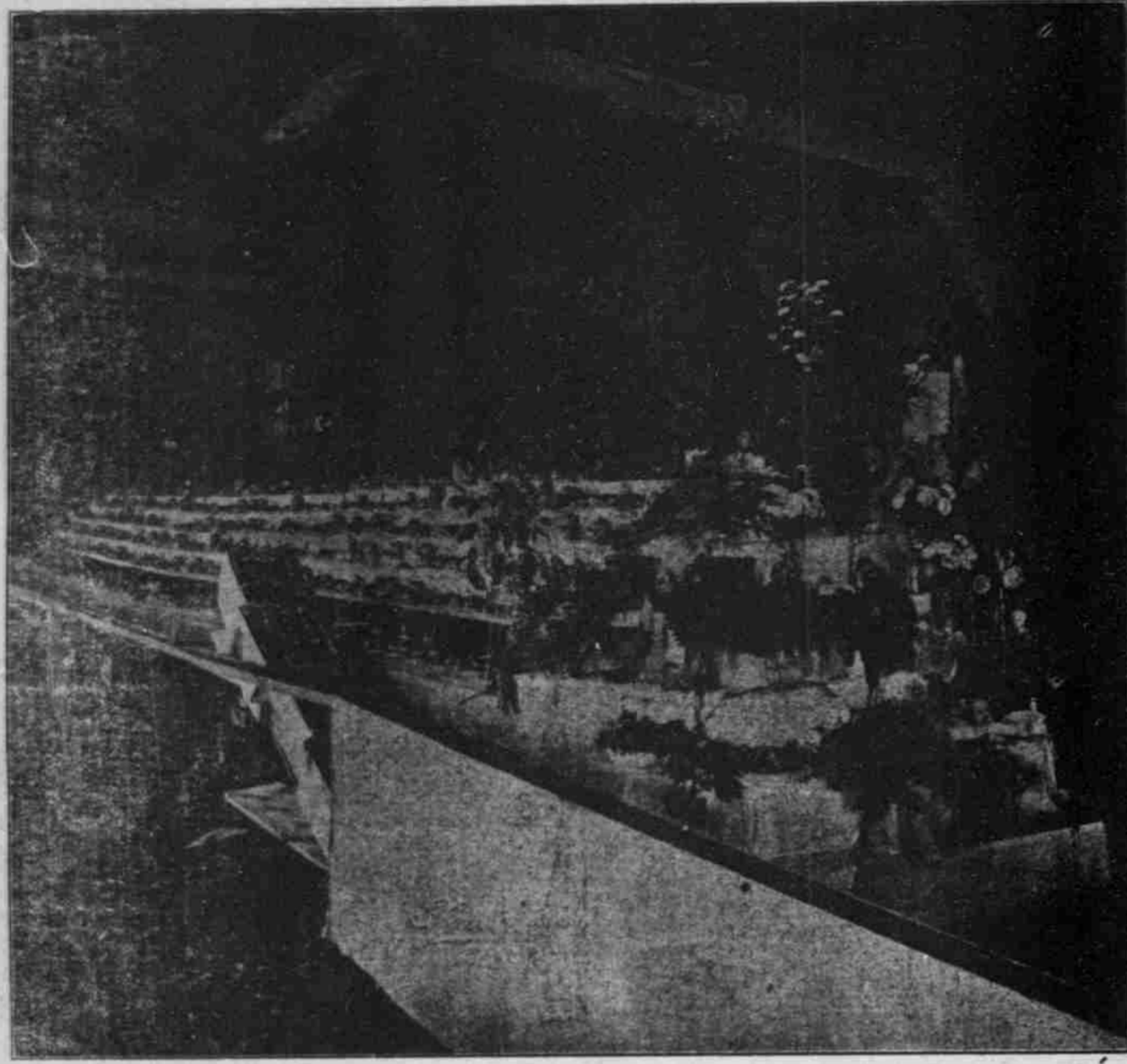
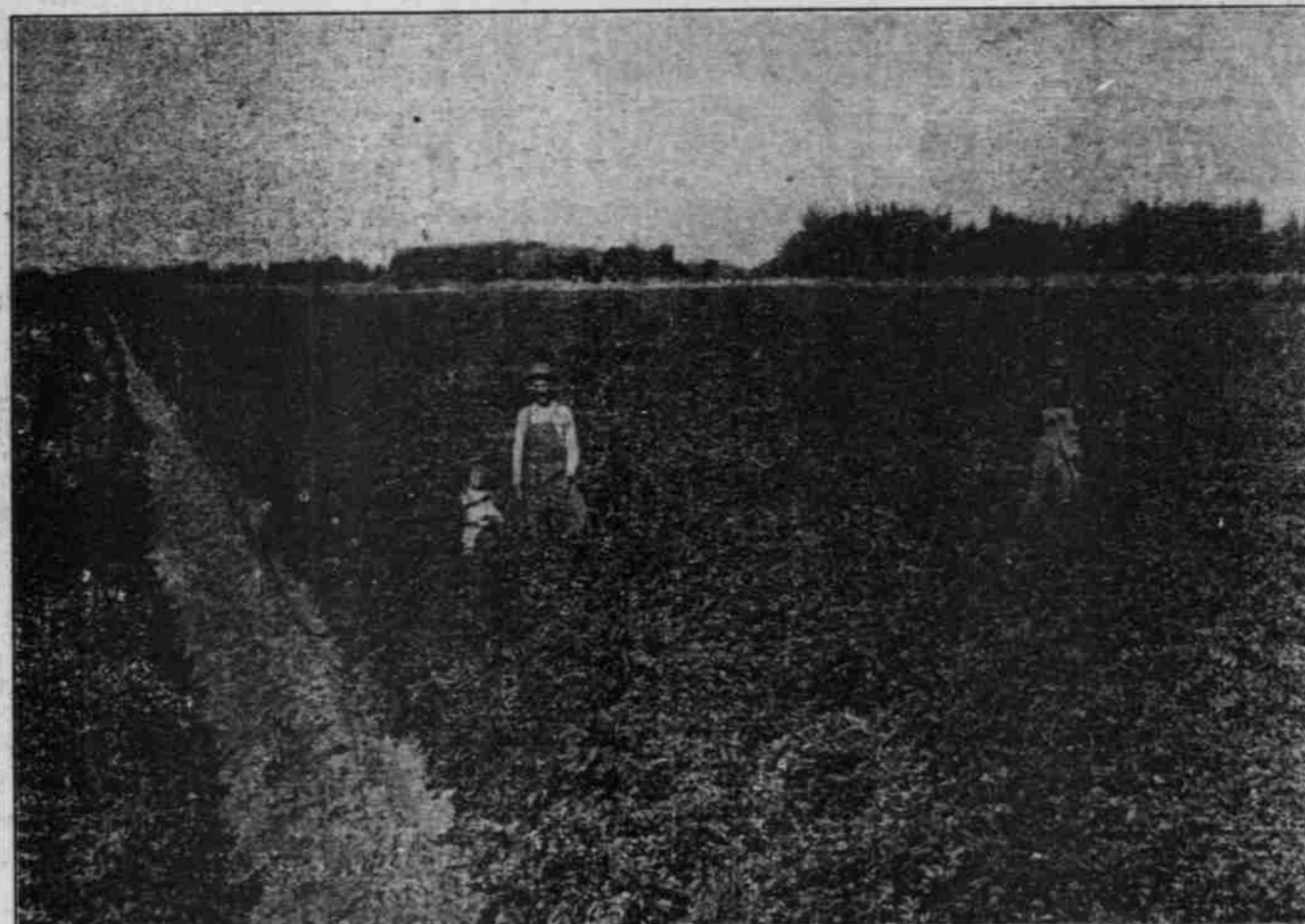

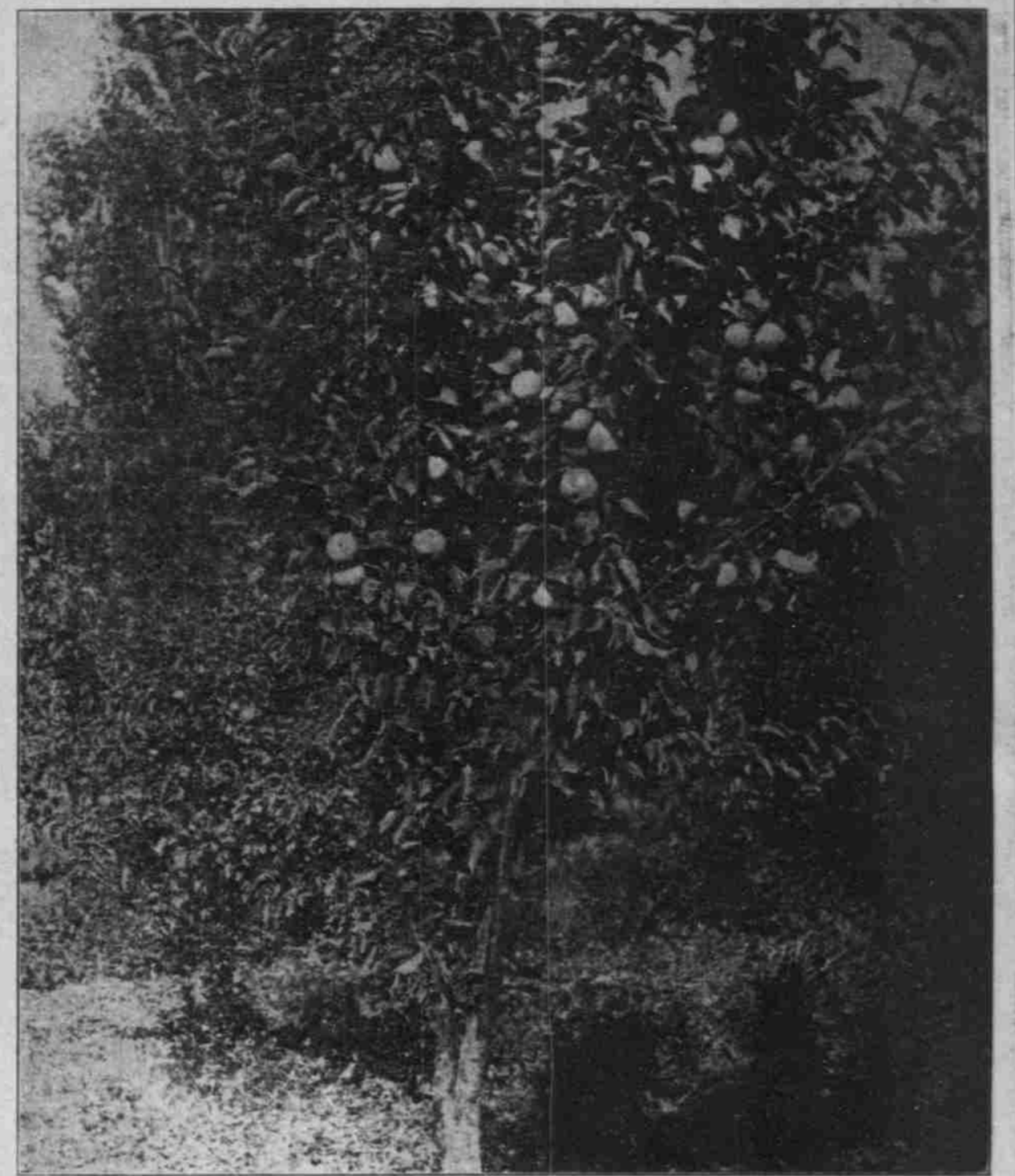


FRUIT EXHIBIT FROM BLACKFOOT

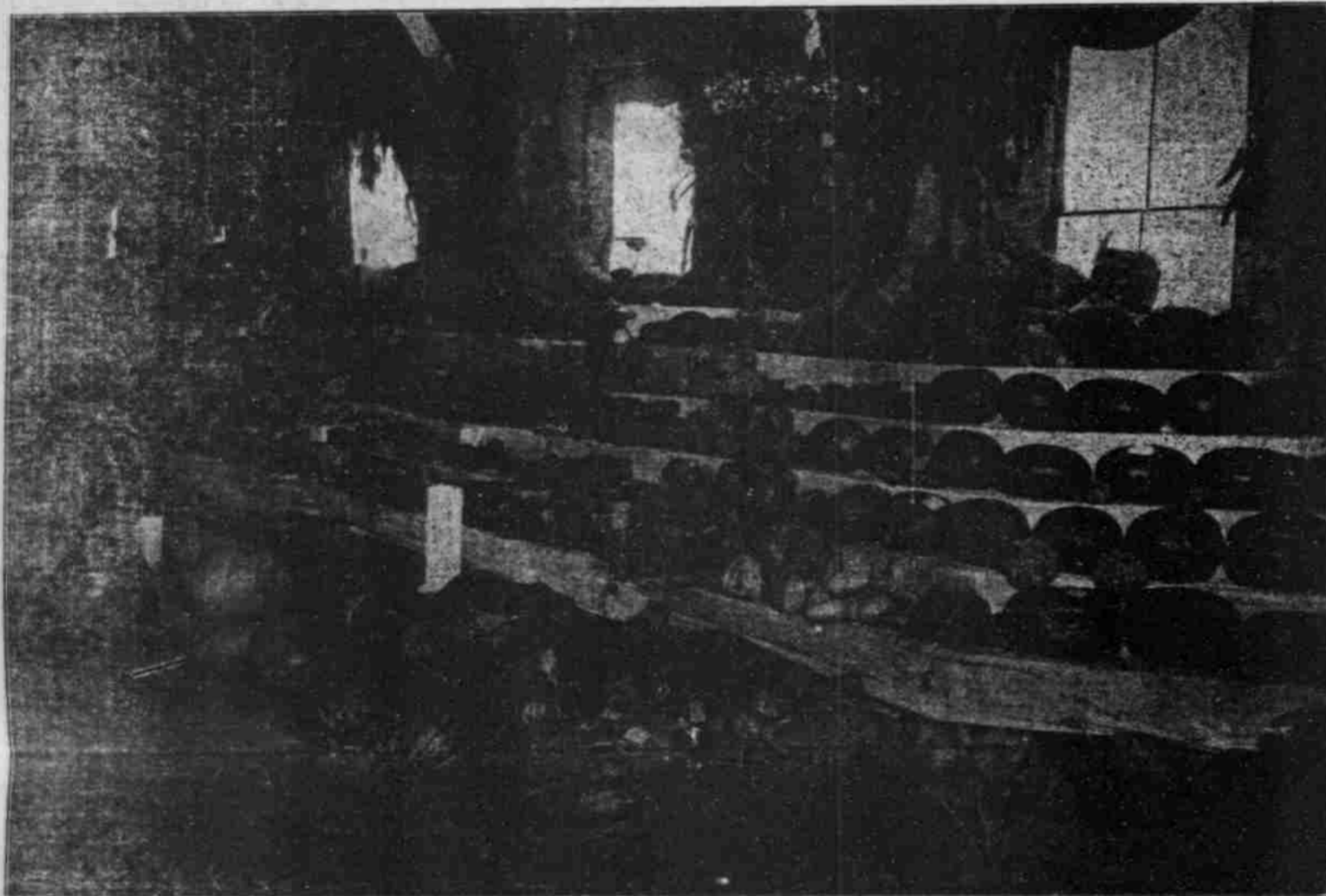


GROWING POTATOES AT BLACKFOOT. 425 BUSHELS PER ACRE

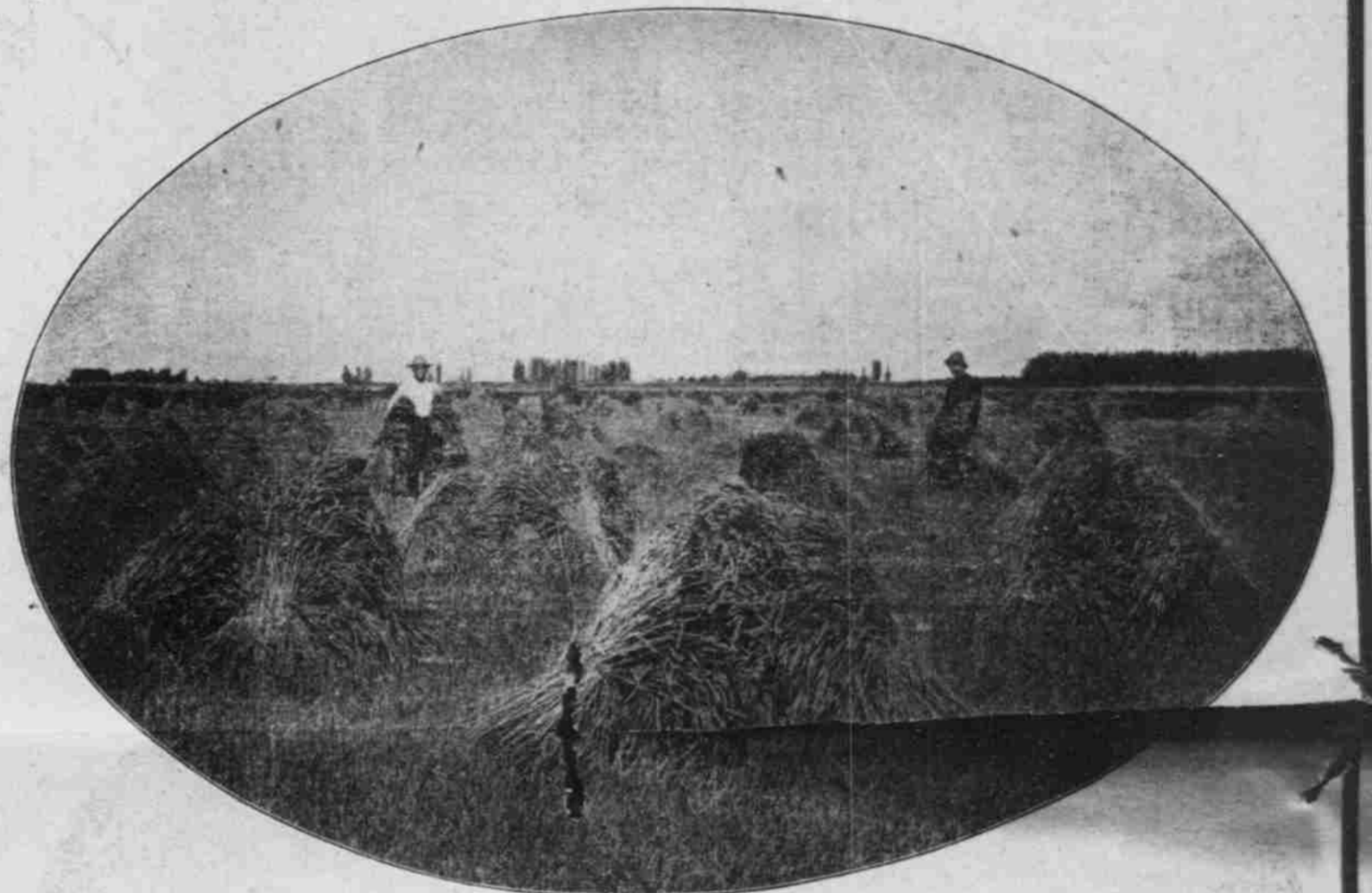


SOME MORE BLACKFOOT PRODUCTS

And Crops are Always Sure

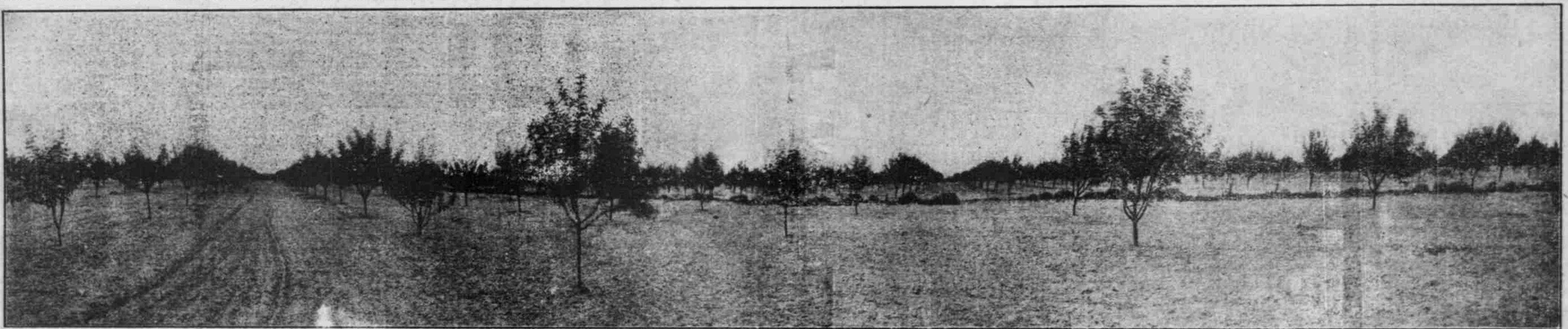
- Potatoes, 300 to 800 bushels per acre

WHEAT FIELD AT BLACKFOOT

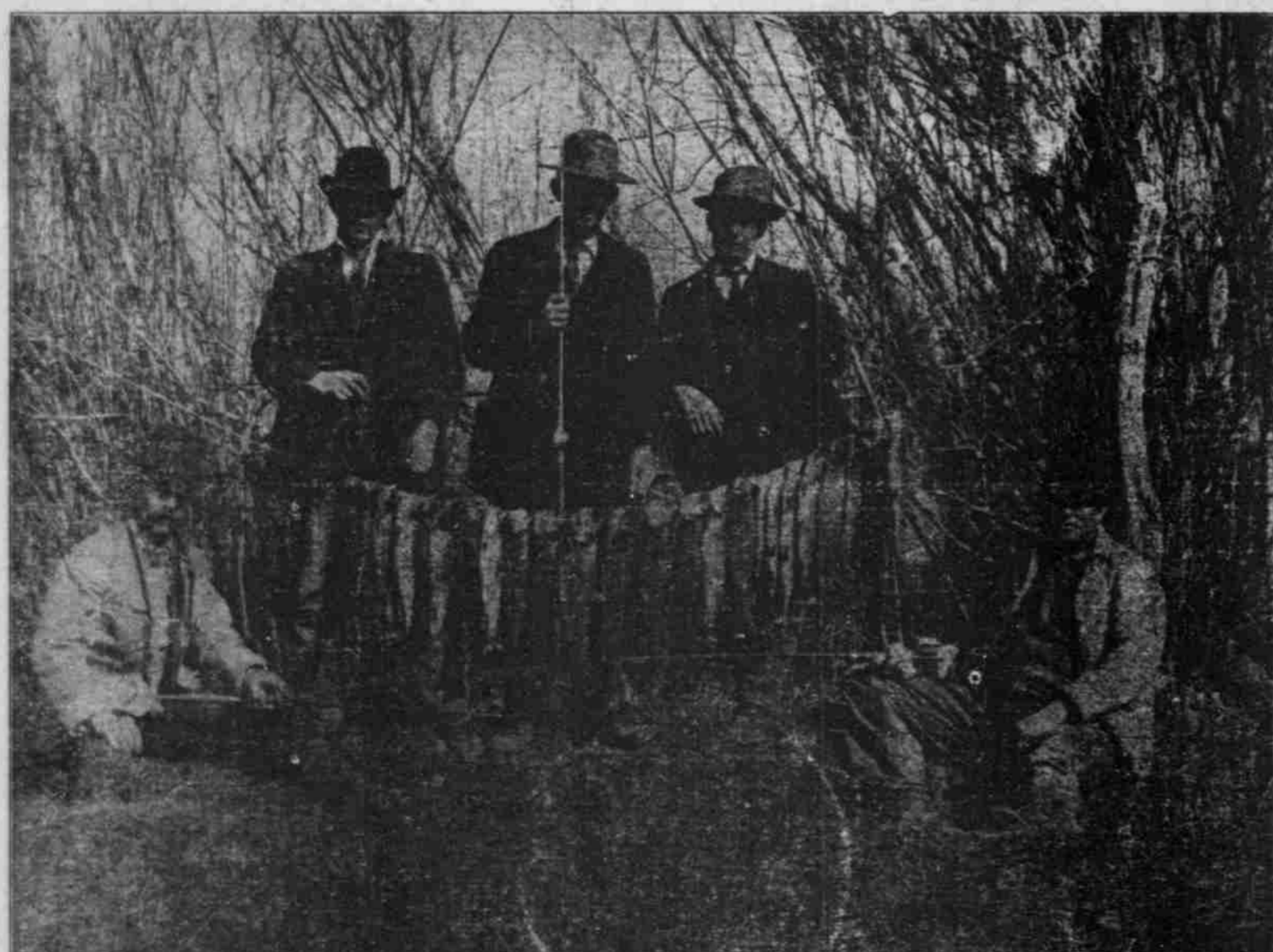
