SUPERINTENDENT MAKES GOOD SHOWING

Schools of Box Butte County in Prosperous and Flourishing Condition

CONDENSED REPORT BELOW

The annual report of Miss Della Reed, county superintendent of schools, to the state superintendent of public instruction, for the year ending the second Monday of July, 1913, shows that the schools of Box Butte county are in a very prosperous and flourishing condition. It is impossible, on account of lack of space, to give the complete report, so we are giving a synopsis of the same in tabulated form below.

Districts number 35, 47, 48, 72 and 92 are in Box Butte county but the school houses for these districts are located in adjoining counties.

Totals
 The total cash in hands of district treasurers at the close of last year was \$6,102.30; received from county and township treasurers, \$12,518.37; from sale of district bonds, \$15,502.07; from tuition of non-resident pupils, \$887.05; from local fines and licenses, \$4,116; from all other sources, \$18,700.22.

There was paid to male teachers the sum of \$6,086.40; to female teachers, \$32,191.20; for building house and site, \$20,606.98; for repairs, \$2165.66; for fuel, \$3,458.78; for books under library law, \$124.13; for text books and supplies, \$3,276.72; for furniture, \$3,226.77; for all other purposes, \$6,759.71; now in hands of district treasurers, \$9,929.56.

Amount of outstanding bonds, \$62,700; amount of other indebtedness, \$8,829.11; total indebtedness, \$71,529.11; value of schoolhouses, \$28,792; total value of district property, \$46,171.

Number of children between 5 and 21 years of age, 2,042; total enrollment, 1,420. Number of school houses, 45. Number of teachers employed, 79.

Number of visits to schools by county superintendent for year, 125. Number of private schools, 3.
