

# BOY BITTEN BY MAD DOG

Keith Thompson, Aged 12, Bitten by Dog at Seneca. Dog Heads Sent to Kansas City

(By Herald Correspondent.)

Seneca, Nebr., Feb. 3.—Dr. I. H. Phillips, health officer, has received a telegram from Kansas City in which he was informed that a number of the dogs' heads which he sent there to be examined, showed rabid infection. Later he was notified to see that all dogs were either killed or tied up. The heads were sent to Kansas City on account of Keith Thompson being bitten by a stray dog on Sunday.

Kansas City, Mo., Feb. 3.—The doctors here announce that there is very little danger that Keith Thompson, of Seneca, Nebr., has hydrophobia. It seems that the boy was bitten by a stray dog he was playing with.

The head of the dog was sent here with several others. No traces of hydrophobia were found in the head of the dog which bit the boy.
