NEWLY REVEALED WONDERLAND

POLITICS AND POLITICIANS

New York Progressives are still hopeful that Col. Roosevelt will run for governor this year.

Members of the bar from all parts of New England went to Marshfield, Mass., to attend the dedication of the memorial tablet placed on the house in which Daniel Webster lived during the last 20 years of his life.

One of the greatest reclamation projects on the North American continent has just been completed by the Canadian government in the building of the Bassano dam near Calgary, Alberta. The dam measures 7,000 feet in length, 400 feet longer than the Assouan dam on the Nile.

The French government has put into effect the new law passed last March calling for a tax of 5 per cent upon the income received from foreign stocks, bonds and securities of any form, including government bonds. Financial interests have been bringing enormous pressure to bear against the measure.

South Carolina will have one of the most sensational campaigns in its history this year. Senatorial candidates have already begun speech-making, while candidates for the various state offices expect to reach the height of their campaign about the middle of next month.

Mrs. Leonora M. Lake of St. Louis, one of the best known temperance workers in the country, declares that the liquor traffic is doomed to pass out of existence during the next ten years. "Men and women are the nation's best asset," says Mrs. Lake, "and every nation that has forgotten this truth has gone down to oblivion."

The United States is planning to build within the near future a new embassy in Mexico City, to cost \$150,000. Another at Tokio will cost \$100,000, while the legation at Berne, Switzerland is to be erected for \$140,000.

Despite the fact that she was opposed by several men, Mrs. Mildred R. Brooks has been nominated on the Republican ticket for recorder of Marion county, Ore., having led her nearest competitor by two to one.
