ORDINANCE NO. 213

An Ordinance providing for the assessment and collection of a tax upon all the taxable property abutting upon improvement districts...

WHEREAS, it having been adjudged, determined and established by the council of said city sitting as a Board of Equalization...

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLIANCE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That for the cost of the construction of curbing in Improvement Districts Number One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Six (6) in the City of Alliance, Nebraska...

Section 2. That said special taxes levied as aforesaid on said lots, parts of lots and real estate shall become delinquent as follows: One-tenth of the total amount so levied on said lots and real estate shall become delinquent in fifty days from the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance...

Section 3. That any person owning any of the aforesaid property shall have the right and be permitted to pay any one or more of said payments, or may pay the whole of said tax and receive the treasurer's receipt therefor upon the payment of all the tax so levied, and the said tax shall be fully discharged of record, provided the same is paid within fifty days from the passage of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
