

She said that the largest C. E. S. in the world is found on the Congo, being composed of 2,000. They are hungry for the gospel, 8,000 attending one communion service.

Denver officers of the National committee of the Africian Race of America have sent broadcast a call to a convention to be held in Denver next August. Delegates from every state in the Union will be asked to attend. The chief purpose of the meeting is to consider the rights of the American negro as citizens. If the convention decides the race cannot be accepted into full citizenship in the United States with all the actual privileges by other race groups, they will discuss the possibility of colonizing Liberia in Africa.

THREE PROMINENT WHITE MEN OUTRAGE COLORED GIRL

A few days ago in Girard, Ohio, a colored girl, fourteen years old, while on an errand was approached by a white man named McRush and decoyed to a barn where two other white men were lying in wait. Both were married men with families and belonged to the wealthy families of

They seized the child and kept her n the barn for three days and nights. She was most shamefully abused and outraged, then released and threatened with death if she told of her treatment that she received at the hands of those beasts incarnate. Undaunted by the threats of these fiends she went at once and reported the matter. A warrant was promptly sworn out, but a conspiracy was formed among the law enforcing power and the warrants were never served. The mayor went so far as to prostitute his office for a little money four hours the three nice beasts were in the county jail.
