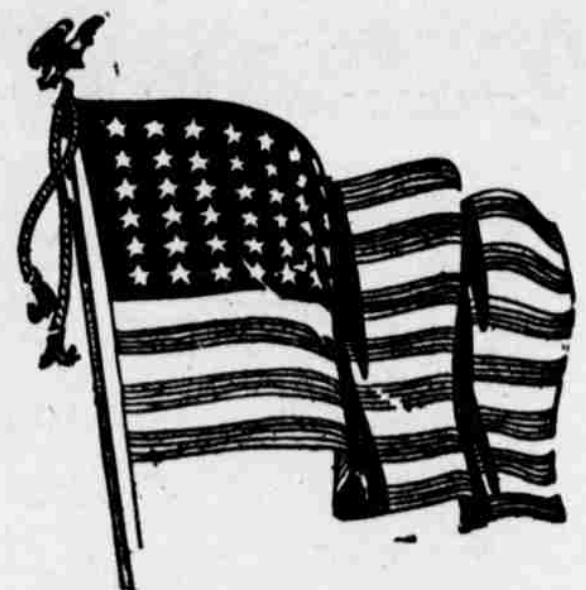

President's Thanksgiving Proclamation



"By the President of the United States, Woodrow Wilson, Proclamation No. 2466, October 3, 1917."

"It has long been the custom of our people to assemble themselves during their annual harvest to give thanks to the Lord their God for the bounty of His mercies and for the goodness of His land."

"We have been blessed, in the past year, with an autumn of the year's blessings and mercies in the midst of the tragedy of the war, and the gathering about us of blessings that are but the beginning of a new era."

"In this day of our national history, we have been blessed with the spirit of men who have shown a practical and patriotic economy in their conduct of a day which has been divided or wondrously preserved."

"And while we are in all humbleness of heart, we have been kept constant in our faith and may be directed and protected and security and peace vouchsafed all the more."

"Wherefore, I, Woodrow Wilson, do hereby designate the fourth day of November as a day of Thanksgiving and prayer, and day from their ordinary duties to render thanks to the Lord their God."

"In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and the seal of the United States to be at Washington, D. C., this 3rd day of October, 1917."

"Done in the District of Columbia, this 3rd day of October, 1917."
