

### CARWORLD GAS WELL HAS PROMISING LOOK

Drilling on the Stapleton-Coleman well on the school house hill in this city, was resumed on Thursday and continued but a short time when the gas flow became stronger, and principally on account of the loose dirt (apparently from caving) interfering it was considered best to cease drilling and case the well with 6-inch casing before drilling is resumed, says the Crawford Tribune.

When the flow of gas was noticed to be stronger it created quite an excitement again, as it is an indication that the gas is not merely a small pocket, but will prove a strong continuous flow when the well is cleaned out, cased and drilled to a greater depth, which is the intention of the management. A torch was applied to the escaping gas again and after flaming for a short time was extinguished as formerly, by covering with wet boards and dirt.

#### MAY 1 IS PROCLAIMED AMERICANIZATION DAY

May 1, has been designated by Governor McKelvie as Americanization Day and he has issued the following proclamation:  
 "The recurrence of May 1, demonstrations by radicals who are opposed to organized government and the enforcement of law should be a matter of concern to all loyal Americans. The humiliation that has thus been heaped upon those who believe in the republic as the best form of constitutional government suggests the wisdom of doing something to counteract the effect of such radical demonstrations."  
 "Therefore, as a means of attracting attention to the prime necessity for orderly action and majority rule

in a self-governing democracy, and in order that those who love our republic and its free institutions may give public expression to their sentiments, I, Samuel R. McKelvie, governor of Nebraska, do hereby declare May 1, 1920, as Americanization Day, to be observed throughout our state by a display of the American flag and the giving of other demonstrations as evidence of loyalty to our nation and

faith in its ideals.
