**ATTENDANCE LAST TUESDAY GREATER THAN SEATING CAPACITY OF AUDITORIUM**  
Program Manager Mrs. York Hinman Introduces in a Novel Manner The Talent Which Takes Part.

That the community interest spirit is growing was evidenced by the attendance at the second municipal entertainment Tuesday evening when the attendance was greater than the seating capacity of the big Franklin auditorium. Conservatively estimated, more than 1000 were present.

Mrs. York Hinman officiated as program manager and presented talent that interested the big audience and brought forth well merited applause.

Starr; readings by Miss Dorothy Hinman and Mrs. Frank Buchanan; solo with chorus accompaniment by Mrs. Victor Anderson, trio by Mrs. Anderson, Mrs. L. W. Toole and Mrs. Harry Cramer, piano solo by little Thelma Starr, solo by Prof. Redenbaugh, solo with chorus accompaniment by W. H. Munger, selection by a male chorus, and closing with "The Star Spangled Banner." Each of the numbers was enthusiastically applauded and the performers responded to the encore. The choruses had accompaniment by an orchestra composed of Miss MacKay pianist, Miss Welch violinist, Hershey Welch cellist, Prof. Tout cornet and W. E. Starr clarinet.
