NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION. Notice is hereby given that a special election will be held in the city of North Platte, Lincoln County, Nebraska, on May 15th, 1917, at the city hall, for the purpose of electing the voters of the city having the legal right to do so to vote on the following proposition, to-wit: "Shall the mayor and council of the city of North Platte, Nebraska, have the power and be authorized to issue ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) City of North Platte Bridge Bonds in denominations of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) each dated July 1st, A. D. 1917, due in twenty years from date, but payable at any time after ten years at the option of said city, to draw interest at the rate of five per cent per annum payable semi-annually, principal on interest payable at the office of the state treasurer of the State of Nebraska; said bonds to be issued for the purpose of obtaining money with which to pay the construction of a wagon bridge across the South Platte river, commencing at a point on the north bank of the South Platte river where a culminating of the center line of Locust street in the city of North Platte, Lincoln county, Nebraska, intersects annually with the southeast quarter (S. E. 1/4) of section four (4) in township thirteen (13) north of range thirty-one (31) of the 6th P. M. in Lincoln county, Nebraska, running thence in a southerly direction across the South Platte river about fifteen hundred (1500) feet to a point on the south bank of said river about twenty (20) feet east of a line of section No. 10, of locust bank of said river, Nebraska, at the east end of the bridge end of the present timber bridge on the north bank of said river, and of sufficient width for two teams to pass each other at any point on said bridge and to be constructed of concrete and steel, and to conform with the plans and specifications prepared and approved by the state engineer of the state of Nebraska; said bonds representing approximately one-fourth of the entire cost of the construction of said bridge as hereinbefore set forth, the entire cost of which is to be approximately forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) one-half of such entire sum is to be borne by the state of Nebraska and as provided in Article 3, Chapter 28, Sections 123 to 133 inclusive of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska, for the purpose of paying the balance of the entire cost is to be borne by the city of North Platte, Nebraska; State and city bonds in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 28, Article 3, Sections 41 to 45 inclusive of the Revised Statutes of the State of Nebraska for the year 1917; and shall the proper officers of said city be authorized to levy and collect a tax annually in such manner as to pay the interest and principal of said bonds as they mature and until by law, until said bonds and interest are paid on all the property within said city. Said bonds are to be negotiable in full and the interest shall be evidenced by coupons to said bonds attached.
