SENATE FILES

- 2. Bush, Kimball—Bill to prevent dogs from running into or wallowing in high school grounds.
3. Bush, Kimball—Amends free charge numerical entries by county clerks.
4. Bush, Kimball—Provides for division of irrigation districts...

- 221. Tanner, Douglas—Raises salary of county clerk.
222. Bush, Kimball—Provides that notice of advertisement for bids on coal, hay or other supplies at any time.
223. Educational Committee—Extend maximum school tax to 1.50 per cent of assessed value...

- 224. Bush, Kimball—Provides that maximum school tax on the state treasury shall be 1.50 per cent of assessed value.
225. Wilson, Dodge—Requires that before paying bonds shall be issued where bonds are to be sold, the county clerk be notified in advance at a special or general election.
226. Bush, Kimball—Provides that the board of school directors shall have jurisdiction over the boundaries of village having a population of more than 500 inhabitants...

- 227. McMillen, Ames—Provides for the approval by clerk of district court of order to sell real estate.
228. Bush, Kimball—Provides that village and irrigation districts may purchase real estate at the rate.
229. Educational Committee—Extend maximum school tax to 1.50 per cent of assessed value...
