### AVIATOR LIEUT. LEE BIRD FALLS TO HIS DEATH.

North Platte was shocked Friday afternoon by the receipt of a message announcing the death of Lieut. Lee Bird, an aviator stationed at Brooks Field, Texas, and son of Mr. and Mrs. Hugh W. Bird. Details of the accident which resulted in the death of this splendid young man, could not be obtained by the parents, and will not be known until today, when the body, accompanied by a lieutenant as an escort, will arrive. Press dispatches appearing in Sunday's papers stated that he fell while making a tail spin in the air.

Thirty minutes before the death message arrived, Mr. Bird came into The Tribune office and handed us a letter from Lee to read, in which he stated that he had made application for a leave of absence and would probably start home December 15th to remain until after the holidays.

As an aviator Lee had made wonderful progress, had completed his course of instructions and received his commission. At the time of his death he was an instructor.

Lieut. Bird was one of the first selective draft men to leave Lincoln county, enlisting for Camp Funston the early part of September last year. A few months later he was transferred to the aviation corps, and for eight or nine months had been stationed at fields in Texas.

Born in North Platte, graduating from the high school and later attending the state university and School of Mines at Golden, Col., Lieut. Lee Bird was a young man of more than ordinary capability, of splendid character and well liked by all who knew him.
