BEEF GROWERS ADOPT SLIDING SCALE PRICE

Denver, Jan. 28.—Sugar beet growers members of the National Sugar Beet Growers' association, in convention here, voted to demand more money for their product.

The association voted to demand contracts calling for prices ranging from \$12 to \$21 a ton, based on a minimum of 9 cents a pound for sugar.

Wages of farm labor in caring for the beet crop will be advanced this summer, the convention agreeing to a 15 per cent increase.
