Sugar Grows on Fir Trees, but at \$66 a Pound

WASHINGTON.—Announcement is made by the American Forestry association of the phenomenon of sugar growing on fir trees in the province of British Columbia and in the eastern part of the state of Washington. This discovery was made by Prof. John Davidson, F. L. S.; F. B. S. E., botanist in charge at the University of British Columbia at Vancouver.
