ORDINANCE NO. 124. An Ordinance Authorizing the Issuance and Delivery of \$10,000.00 City of North Platte Fire House Extension Bonds.

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of North Platte, Lincoln County, Nebraska, are hereby authorized to issue under their signature and the seal of said City Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars in "City of North Platte Fire House Extension Bonds" in denominations of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the City of North Platte, in the County of Lincoln, in the State of Nebraska, acknowledges itself indebted and for value received hereby promises to pay to the bearer or holder hereof the sum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS in lawful money of the United States of America on the first day of October, A. D. 1921, with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of six per cent (6 per cent) per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of April and the first day of October of each year that said bond is to run, upon the presentation and surrender of the interest coupons hereto attached, to the extent said interest; both principal and interest payable at the office of the county Treasurer of Lincoln County, State of Nebraska, and for the prompt payment of said principal and interest, the full faith, credits, resources and all taxable property of the said City of North Platte, in the County of Lincoln, State of Nebraska, are hereby irrevocably pledged.

THIS BOND is one of the series of like tenor and date, issued for the purpose of raising funds for the building and extension to the fire house in the City of North Platte, and for the equipping of the same in accordance with plans and specifications and estimates on file with the City Clerk under and by virtue of and in full and strict conformity with the provisions of the Nebraska Constitution and with the Revised Statutes of Nebraska for 1913, being paragraph 4771, Section 127, thereof as amended by the 1919 Legislature of the State of Nebraska, and any and all other laws and authority thereunto supplemental, amendatory or enabling; and in pursuance of the necessary petition, ordinance and all requisite legal action by the Mayor and Council of the City of North Platte, duly passed and published, and any and all other officials legally or otherwise connected with the issuance of this bond; and under authority of a favorable vote by more than a three-fifths (3-5) majority of the electors of said City of North Platte, duly qualified, as required by law for voting upon such questions at an election legally called and held within said City of North Platte, on the 15th day of October, A. D. 1920.
