

HERE IS A SUGGESTION FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF LOCAL BOY SCOUTS

Dr. Forrest Richard, Sanitary Inspector for the U. S. Public Health Service, recently requested the Boy Scouts of Springfield, Mo., to help exterminate the fly. He said to the boys:

"You have a wonderful opportunity for public service. All nuisances detrimental to health are prohibited by law in this state and the public health and sanitary departments want your co-operation in locating and getting rid of these nuisances. Report them to your scoutmaster, the sanitary inspector or the health officer, stating the name and address of persons and the nature of nuisances maintained. You will be doing a great service to the community in which you live by furnishing this information."

"The fly passes through four distinct stages in its development, namely, egg, maggot, cocoon and lastly the fly we so much dislike. When these pests have reached the last stage they are certainly harder to kill than in the three preceding stages. Once they have developed their gossamer wings and bathed their legs and bodies in disease germs, they usually visit many open surface privies and garbage cans. Then they are ready for dining rooms and sick chambers. The best time to kill the flies is before they begin to fly. They are perhaps more easily located and the least resistant to being destroyed while in the larva or maggot stage. House flies are partial to all filth. It is estimated that about ninety per cent of all house flies breed in horse manure."

"From the time the fly eggs are deposited, it is about ten days until they become full grown flies, ready to start on their career of disease communication, sickness and death. If all horse manure is removed once every week and disposed of either by being scattered out to dry or by being removed one thousand feet or more from any building used as a dwelling or food establishment, the fly problem would be considerably lessened. The stable and barn yards should be allowed to dry thoroughly after removing the manure, then sprinkled with lime to kill any fly maggots that may have been left behind."

ORDINANCE NUMBER 126

An ordinance providing for the submitting to the electors of the City of North Platte, Lincoln County, State of Nebraska, the following question, to-wit:

"Shall the City of North Platte, in the County of Lincoln, State of Nebraska, issue its 'City of North Platte Sewer Bonds' in the sum of \$65,000.00 for the purpose of raising money for the constructing, improving, enlarging, maintaining and aiding in the construction of a system of sewerage in said City in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates on file with the City Clerk; and to provide for the levying and collecting by the proper officers of said city, a tax annually to pay the interest and principal of said bonds as they mature."

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of North Platte, Nebraska:

SECTION 1. That a special election shall be held in the City of North Platte, Lincoln County, Nebraska, on the 21st day of June, 1921, at which election the following proposition shall be submitted to the voters of said City:

"Shall the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Platte, Lincoln County, State of Nebraska, issue \$65,000.00 of the 'City of North Platte Sewer Bonds' in the sum of One Thousand Dollars each, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, payable semi-annually, interest and principal payable at the office of the County Treasurer of Lincoln County, State of Nebraska, and said bonds to bear date of July 1st, 1921, and the interest on said bonds to be paid on the 1st day of January, 1922, and on the 1st day of July, 1922, and on the 1st day of July of each and every year thereafter, until all interest on said bonds shall have been paid. Said bonds to be numbered consecutively from 1 to 65 inclusive, and the interest thereon to be evidenced by coupons thereto attached. Said bonds shall be drawn payable to bearer Twenty Years after date but redeemable at the option of the city at any time after Five years from the date thereof, and shall the City of North Platte, Lincoln County, Nebraska, levy a tax in the year 1921, and each and every year thereafter sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds, and in the year 1921 and each and every year thereafter sufficient to create a sinking fund to pay the principal of said bonds as they become due until sufficient tax has been levied to pay all of the interest and principal of said bonds, and such tax to be both for principal and interest and to be levied upon all of the taxable property in said City of North Platte, Lincoln County, State of Nebraska."

Said bonds to be used for the purpose of raising money for the constructing, improving, enlarging, maintaining and aiding in the construction of a system of sewerage in said City of North Platte, Lincoln County, State of Nebraska.

"FOR" Issuing One Hundred Thousand Dollars of the 'City of North Platte Water Works Improvement Bonds' in the sum of One Hundred Dollars each, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, payable semi-annually, interest and principal payable at the office of the County Treasurer of Lincoln County, State of Nebraska, and said bonds to bear date of July 1st, 1921, and the interest on said bonds to be paid on the 1st day of January, 1922, and on the 1st day of July, 1922, and on the 1st day of July of each and every year thereafter, until all interest on said bonds shall have been paid. Said bonds to be numbered consecutively from 1 to 100 inclusive, and the interest thereon to be evidenced by coupons thereto attached. Said bonds shall be drawn payable to bearer Twenty Years after date but redeemable at the option of the City at any time after Five Years from the date thereof, and shall the City of North Platte, Lincoln County, Nebraska, levy a tax in the year 1921, and each and every year thereafter sufficient to pay the principal of said bonds as they become due until a sufficient tax has been levied to pay all of the principal and interest of said bonds and such tax to be both for principal and interest and to be levied upon all of the taxable property in said City of North Platte, Lincoln County, State of Nebraska."

SECTION 6. The ballots to be used in said election shall have printed thereon:

"FOR" Issuing One Hundred Thousand Dollars of the 'City of North Platte Water Works Improvement Bonds' in the sum of One Hundred Dollars each, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, payable semi-annually, interest and principal payable at the office of the County Treasurer of Lincoln County, State of Nebraska, and said bonds to bear date of July 1st, 1921, and the interest on said bonds to be paid on the 1st day of January, 1922, and on the 1st day of July, 1922, and on the 1st day of July of each and every year thereafter, until all interest on said bonds shall have been paid. Said bonds to be numbered consecutively from 1 to 100 inclusive, and the interest thereon to be evidenced by coupons thereto attached. "AGAINST" Issuing One Hundred Thousand Dollars of the 'City of North Platte Water Works Improvement Bonds' in the sum of One Hundred Dollars each, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, payable semi-annually, interest and principal payable at the office of the County Treasurer of Lincoln County, State of Nebraska, and said bonds to bear date of July 1st, 1921, and the interest on said bonds to be payable on the 1st day of January, 1922, and on the 1st day of July, 1922, and on the 1st day of July of each and every year thereafter until all of the interest on said bonds shall have been paid; to levy a tax in the year 1921 and each and every year thereafter sufficient to pay the interest and principal of said bonds as they become due and until sufficient tax has been levied to pay all of the principal and interest of said bonds and such tax to be both for principal and interest and to be levied upon all of the taxable property in said City of North Platte, Lincoln County, Nebraska."

SECTION 3. Those voting in favor of said proposition shall mark their ballots with an "X" after the paragraph beginning with the words "FOR" Issuing One Hundred Thousand Dollars of the City of North Platte Water Works Improvement Bonds."

Those voting against said proposition shall mark their ballots with an "X" after the paragraph beginning with the words "AGAINST" Issuing One Hundred Thousand Dollars of the City of North Platte Water Works Improvement Bonds."

SECTION 4. Notice of said election shall be given by the publication of a notice thereof in the North Platte Telegraph, and in the North Platte Semi-Weekly Tribune, the former being a weekly newspaper and the latter a semi-weekly, both printed and published in North Platte, Lincoln County, Nebraska, and of general circulation in said county; each of said newspapers having been designated as the official papers of said City; said notice to be published for 5 weeks, prior to the said date of election and the said clerk is hereby instructed to cause publication of said notice to be made.

SECTION 5. Said election will be open at 8 o'clock in the morning and continue open until 8 o'clock in the evening of said day of election.

SECTION 6. The polling places of said election will be at the A. N. Durbin Garage, intersection of 5th and Dewey Sts., in the First Ward of said City; and in the District Court Room in the County Court House in the Second Ward in said City; and at the City Hall in the Third Ward in said City; and at the Buick Garage at the intersection of Locust and 8th Sts., in the Fourth Ward, or such other places as may be designated in the notice calling said election. Said election to be conducted in manner and form as provided by the ordinance of said city and the statutes of the State of Nebraska.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
