ORDINANCE NO. 133 An ordinance providing for the construction of a sewer lateral district "Number one" to consist of Blocks numbered 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 28.

Miltonberger's - Addition to North Platte, at proper depth and on a level required by the present sewer system of said city, beginning on the east center line of Block 28.

Section 3. That the engineer of said city at once prepare and file with the clerk thereof an estimate of the total costs of said proposed sewer lateral.

Section 4. That after said estimate is made and filed as herein provided, the Clerk of said city shall proceed at once to advertise in manner and form required by law for bids for the construction of said sewer lateral and appliances.

Section 5. If an approved bid be made for said works that the contract therefor be entered into by the Mayor of said City attested by the Clerk with the necessary provisions and protecting the interests of said city.

Section 6. To pay the costs of the construction of said sewer lateral, flush tanks, man-holes, and appliances, a special assessment shall be levied, according to law, against the lots abutting on the line of said lateral.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and approval and publication. Passed and approved this 4th day of October, 1921.
