NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given to the Electors of the City of North Platte, Nebraska that the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, have provided by ordinance for the submission to a direct vote of the voters of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, the following proposition:

And by virtue of the power in me vested, I hereby call an election on said ordinance to be held in the City of North Platte, Nebraska, on the 16th day of May, 1922.

Those voting in favor of said ordinance shall mark their ballot with an "X" before the paragraph beginning with the word "FOR" issuing Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) of the Paving Bonds of the City of North Platte, Nebraska in denomination of One Thousand and No 100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars, each bearing interest at the rate of Six (6) per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, interest and principal at the office of the County Treasurer of Lincoln County, State of Nebraska. Said bonds to bear date of June 1st, 1922, and the interest on said bonds to be payable on the 1st day of December 1922 and the 1st day of June 1923 and on the 1st day of June of each and every year thereafter until all interest on said Bonds shall have been paid.

day of June 1923 and on the 1st day of June of each and every year thereafter until all interest on said Bonds shall have been paid. Said Bonds to be numbered consecutively from one to fifty, inclusive and the interest thereon to be evidenced by coupons thereto attached.

These voting against said ordinance shall mark their ballot with an "X" before the paragraph beginning with the word "AGAINST" issuing Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars of the "Paving Bonds of the City of North Platte, Nebraska", in denominations of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars each bearing interest at the rate of Six (6) per cent per annum payable semi-annually, interest and principal payable at the office of the County Treasurer of Lincoln County, State of Nebraska. Said Bonds to bear date of June 1st, 1922 and the interest on said Bonds to be payable on the 1st day of December 1922 and the 1st day of June 1923 and on the 1st day of June of each and every year thereafter, until all interest on said Bonds shall have been paid.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, that the following streets including the intersections thereof within the limits of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 144. An Ordinance Providing for the Paving of Certain Streets Within the City of North Platte and for the Creation of Paving District No. Ten of Said City. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, that the following streets including the intersections thereof within the limits of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 145. An Ordinance Providing for the Paving of Certain Streets Within the City of North Platte and for the Creation of Paving District No. Eleven of Said City. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, that the following streets including the intersections thereof within the limits of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 146. An Ordinance Providing for the Paving of Certain Streets Within the City of North Platte and for the Creation of Paving District No. Twelve of Said City. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, that the following streets including the intersections thereof within the limits of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 147. An Ordinance Providing for the Paving of Certain Streets Within the City of North Platte and for the Creation of Paving District No. Thirteen of Said City. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, that the following streets including the intersections thereof within the limits of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, to-wit:

District No. 10 of the said City of North Platte and said Paving District of said City is hereby created. The benefits of the improvement shall be considered as extending 132 feet back from street.

ORDINANCE NO. 151. An ordinance providing for and authorizing the issuance of district paving bonds of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, said paving bonds to be known as district paving bonds of District No. 17.

ORDINANCE NO. 152. An ordinance providing for and authorizing the issuance of district paving bonds of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, said paving bonds to be known as district paving bonds of District No. 18.

ORDINANCE NO. 153. An ordinance providing for and authorizing the issuance of district paving bonds of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, said paving bonds to be known as district paving bonds of District No. 19.

Section 1. That the following streets including the intersections thereof within the limits of the City of North Platte, Nebraska, to-wit:

Section 2. That all of the streets described in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be and constitute Paving Bonds of District No. 11 of said City of North Platte and said Paving District of said City is hereby created.

Section 3. That there shall be assessed and levied against the property of said District which said property shall constitute all of the property abutting on the streets in said district and other property specially benefited thereby, and a special tax as provided by statute which shall be collected as other taxes of said city and when collected shall constitute a special fund for the payment of said bonds and interest thereon.

Section 4. That in the execution of said bonds the Mayor of said city is hereby empowered to sign said bonds and interest coupons attached in his official capacity as Mayor and the City Clerk shall attest the same under seal of said city and the coupons attached to said bonds shall be signed by the Mayor and attested by the Clerk without the seal and when so signed and attested, the same shall be and constitute a valid obligation of said city.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law. Passed and approved this 7th day of April, 1922.

Section 1. That for the purpose of paying the costs of curbing, guttering and paving the streets exclusive of the intersections of streets and spaces opposite alleys in paving district No. 3 in the city of North Platte, Nebraska, the Mayor and Council of said city be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute and issue bonds of said city of North Platte in the sum of Forty-five Thousand (\$45,000.00) Dollars as hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. Said bonds shall be designated and known as District Paving Bonds of District No. 3 and shall be issued in denominations of \$1,000 each, and be numbered from 1 to 45 inclusive and shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually and said bonds shall have interest coupons attached.

Section 1. That for the purpose of paying the costs of curbing, guttering and paving the streets exclusive of the intersections of streets and spaces opposite the alleys in paving district No. 5 in the city of North Platte, Nebraska, the Mayor and Council of said city be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute and issue bonds of said city of North Platte in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars as hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. Said bonds shall be designated and known as District Paving Bonds of District No. 5 and shall be issued in denominations of \$1,000 each, and be numbered from 1 to 25 inclusive and shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually and said bonds shall have interest coupons attached.

Section 3. That there shall be assessed and levied against the property of said District which said property shall constitute all of the property abutting on the streets in said district and other property specially benefited thereby, and a special tax as provided by statute which shall be collected as other taxes of said city and when collected shall constitute a special fund for the payment of said bonds and interest thereon.

Section 4. That in the execution of said bonds the Mayor of said city is hereby empowered to sign said bonds and interest coupons attached in his official capacity as Mayor and the City Clerk shall attest the same under seal of said city and the coupons attached to said bonds shall be signed by the Mayor and attested by the Clerk without the seal and when so signed and attested, the same shall be and constitute a valid obligation of said city.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law. Passed and approved this 7th day of April, 1922.

Said bonds shall be designated and known as District Paving Bonds of District No. 4 and shall be issued in denominations of \$1,000 each, and be numbered from 1 to 40 inclusive and shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually and said bonds shall have interest coupons attached.
