Last year, through demonstrations given by extension workers, over 21,060 families were reported to have adopted suggestions regarding home arrangement and management; 7,000 kitchens were rearranged, 5,000 water systems installed, 3,000 washing machines and 4,000 steam cookers purchased, 65,000 homes screened, 4,000 septic tanks installed, and 7,000 lighting systems placed in farm homes.


