Ballot. Thursday afternoon the republican national convention at St. Louis nominated the next president of the United States-William McKinley, of Ohio. He received 6611/2 votes out of a total of 906. Garrett A. Hobart, of New Jersey, was nominated for vice president on the first ballot, receiving 5351/2 votes.
