

An ordinance to prevent the spread of contagibus and infectuous diseases within the city of O'Neill, Nebraska. and providing for a quarantine against the same, and punishining a violation of the same.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and city conneil of the city of O'Neill, Nebraska: That it shall be the duty of any and all physicians practicing their professions within the city limits of the city of O'Neill. Nebraska, who shall hereafter within said city limits have any person under his care, charge, control or advice, who shall be affected with any contagious or infectious disease, to forthwith report the same in writing signed by him, to the Mayor of said city of O'Neill, or in case of his absence to the president of the city council of said city upon a blank furnished by said city, which report shall state the person or persons so affected, by what disease, and the street and block where such diseased person may be found.

It shall be the duty of all physicians and

block where such diseased person may be found.

It shall be the duty of all physicians and health officers who may in attending their patients or in the discarge of their duty come in contact with any person affected with such contagious or infectious disease or who may enter the house wherein such person so affected may be, to use all precautions and preventatives known to the physicians to prevent the carrying of such disease to other persons.

All quarantine regulations are hereby vested in the Mayor of said city of O'Neill Nebraska, who shall have full power and authority at any and all times, when in his judgment it is necessary in order to prevent the spread of any such contagious or infectious disease within the city limits of said city of O'Neill, Nebraska, to close any school house, school, church, hall, society, place of anusement, opera house, hotel, inn, tavern, place of business or dwelling house, and to prevent public gatherings, and to keep the same closed so long as in his judgment the same may require.

The Mayor shall upon being notified of the
