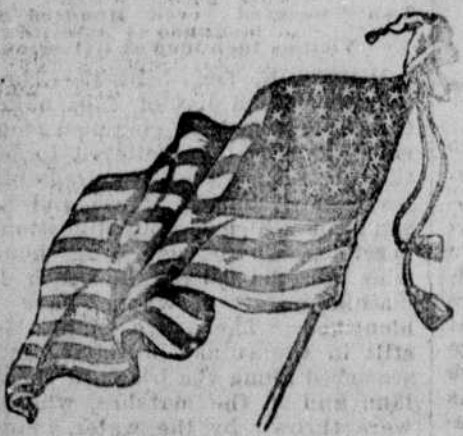


COL. ROOSEVELT
