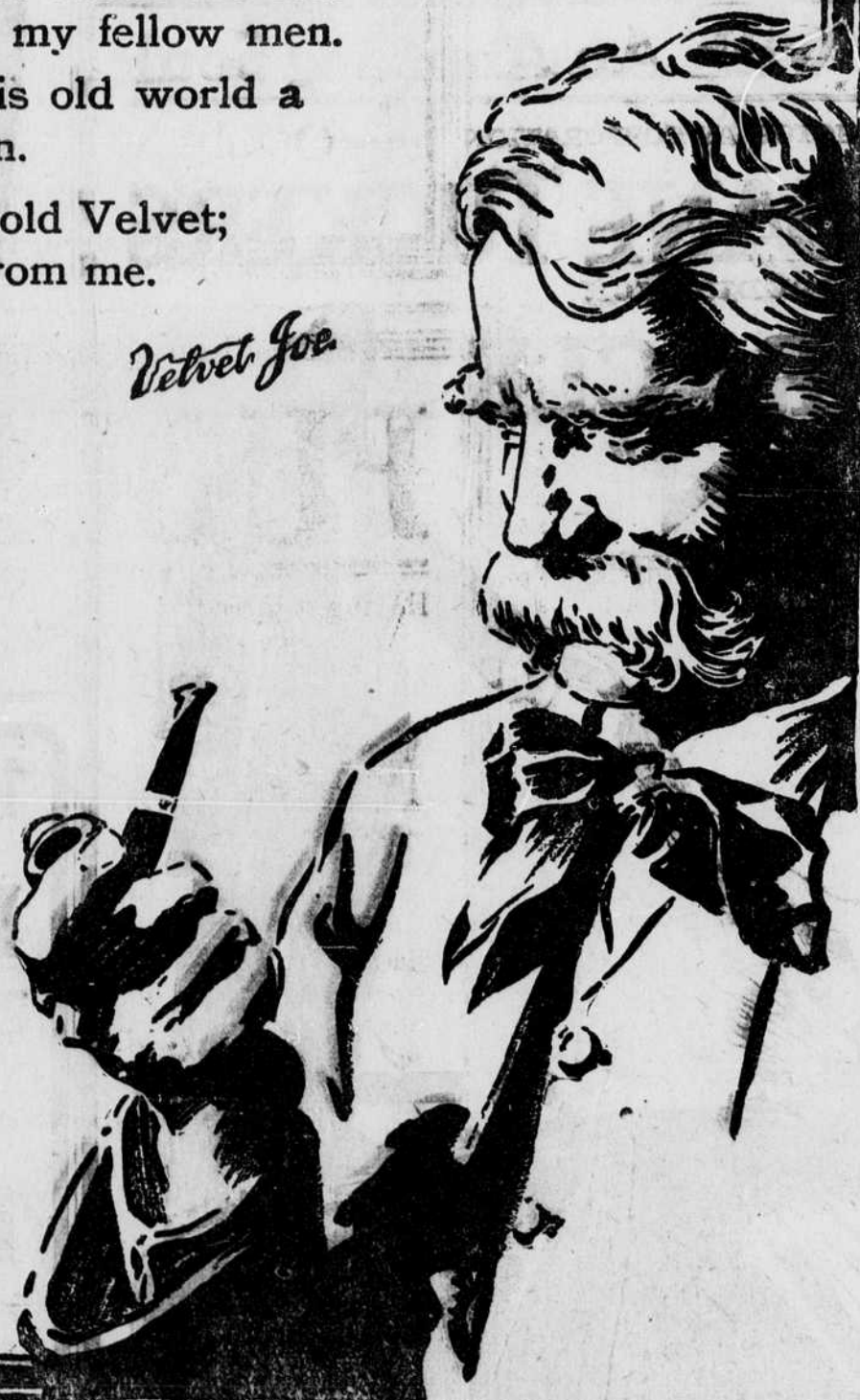

tion Fourteen (14) in the township last aforesaid, thence due South One half (½) mile, thence due west one half (½) mile to the Northwest corner of Section Twenty-three (23), in the last named township, thence due South Three (3) miles to the Southwest corner of Section Thirty-five (35) in said township, thence due East Two and One half (2½) miles to the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Twenty-nine (29), Range Fourteen (14), thence due North Four and One half (4½) miles to the middle point of Section Seven (7), first aforesaid, which is the point of beginning, all in Holt county, Nebraska.
