



Soldiers Bodies to Be Burned: Secretary Baker informed Chairman Wadsworth of the senate military committee that the bodies of 50,000 American soldiers would be brought home from France. Shortage of material used in manufacture of coffins is handicapping the work. The cost of returning these bodies to America is estimated at \$30,000,000.00. Bodies of 20,000 to 25,000 will remain in France.
