

SUPERVISORS' PROCEEDINGS.

O'Neill, Neb., Sept. 27, 1921, 10 a. m. County Board met pursuant to adjournment. All members present but Skidmore and Sullivan. Called to order by chairman.

To the Honorable County Board of Holt County, Nebraska:

We, the undersigned residents and legal voters of Holt County, Nebraska, and residing within five miles of the road herein proposed to be vacated hereby petition your honorable body and ask that the part of the public road hereinafter described be vacated, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the NE 1/4 of Section Two (2), in Township Thirty-two (32), North of Range Sixteen (16) West of the 6th P. M. in Holt County, Nebraska, to thence East on the Township line to the Northwest corner of Section One (1), in said Township and Range; Thence South on the Section line a distance of Two miles; We ask that the prayer of the foregoing petition be granted, only on condition and in the event that a certain other proposed road be granted and established as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the same starting point above designated, to-wit: The NW corner of the NE 1/4 of said Section Two (2); Thence South about 150 Rods, Thence Southwesterly to the northwest corner of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section Ten (10); Thence South on the line which runs through the center of Sections 10 and 15 to a point on said line about Ten Rods South of the Northwest corner of the NE 1/4 of Section 22; Thence in a South-Easterly direction to a point on the Section line between Sections 25 and 26, in said Township and Range, said terminating point being near the northwest corner of the SW 1/4 of said Section 25; Signed by Henry Timmermans and fifteen others.

M. F. Norton was on the 28th day of May, 1921, appointed Special Commissioner to view and report upon the practicability of a change in the above mentioned road, and reported upon same as follows:

To the Hon. Co. Clerk of Holt County, Nebraska:

In compliance with the foregoing

commission on the 28th day of June, 1921, viewed the line of roads as described in said commission. Taking into consideration both private and public convenience, including school privileges, division of lands, etc., I would recommend the opening of the line of road as hereafter described, to-wit: Commencing at the northwest corner of the NE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 32 North of Range 16 West, Center line to run thence South on the 1/4 Section line 37.50 chains, thence South 78 degrees 35 minutes, West 24.00 chains, thence south 38 degrees 20 minutes West 90.00 chains to a point on the 1/4 Section line 33.00 chains south of the northwest corner of the NE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 32, Range 16. Thence South through the center of Sections 10 and 15 and 22-207.00 chains, thence East on section line 120.00 chains to the northeast corner of Section 26, Township 32, Range 16, and there terminate. Also that that part of Road No. 184 commencing at the northeast corner of NW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 32, Range 16, and running East one-half mile, thence South two miles be vacated as requested by petitioners.

Objections and Protest of Fred B. Lee and A. Y. Weir to Proposed Road:

In the matter of the proposed road petitioned for by Henry Timmermans, William Jamison et al. Petition filed by the County Clerk May 25, 1921, and report of M. F. Norton, County Surveyor, as special road commissioner, filed with the County Clerk on June 18, 1921, and designated in Commissioner's report as Road No. 184:

To the County Board of Holt County, Nebraska:

The undersigned Fred B. Lee and A. Y. Weir owners of the land and on each side of and effected by the proposed road, do hereby object to and protest against the establishment of the said road as proposed by the petitioners and as proposed by the said commissioner's report, and for the reason that the existing road as now laid out is sufficient for the purposes and needs of the public, and no necessity exists for the proposed road; and further that the road as proposed by the petitioners therefor and by the report of the commissioner would cut up the ranch owned by the undersigned to such an extent that it would not only require the extra cost of fencing but will diminish to a very large extent the value of the other land in said ranch. And the undersigned further oppose and object to the establishment of said proposed road for the reason that the damages which the undersigned would sustain are greatly in excess of the benefits which would accrue by the establishment of the proposed road, and the undersigned herewith submit their claim for damages if the said road as proposed is established in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).
