To the ordinary citizen that seems to be putting it mildly.

But Judge McCormick's decision will fill with horror many of our "best minds."

A "big lawyer," representing those that got the oil lands that Fall sold for cash, announces that he will appeal the case, and adds, "I have no further comment to make on Judge McCormick's decision."

That statement shows great self-restraint.

"Learned counsel," if it had spoken its mind fully, would have said: "Things have come to a pretty pass when a man worth one hundred millions or so, and badly in need of a hundred million more, cannot keep the property that he buys from a public official with his own good money.

The every day American will be interested in the appeal proceedings, first to the circuit appeals court and then to the supreme court of the United States. The face and the "mind" of any judge who should decide that bribing a public official to deliver public property is a normal business transaction ought to be an interesting study.
