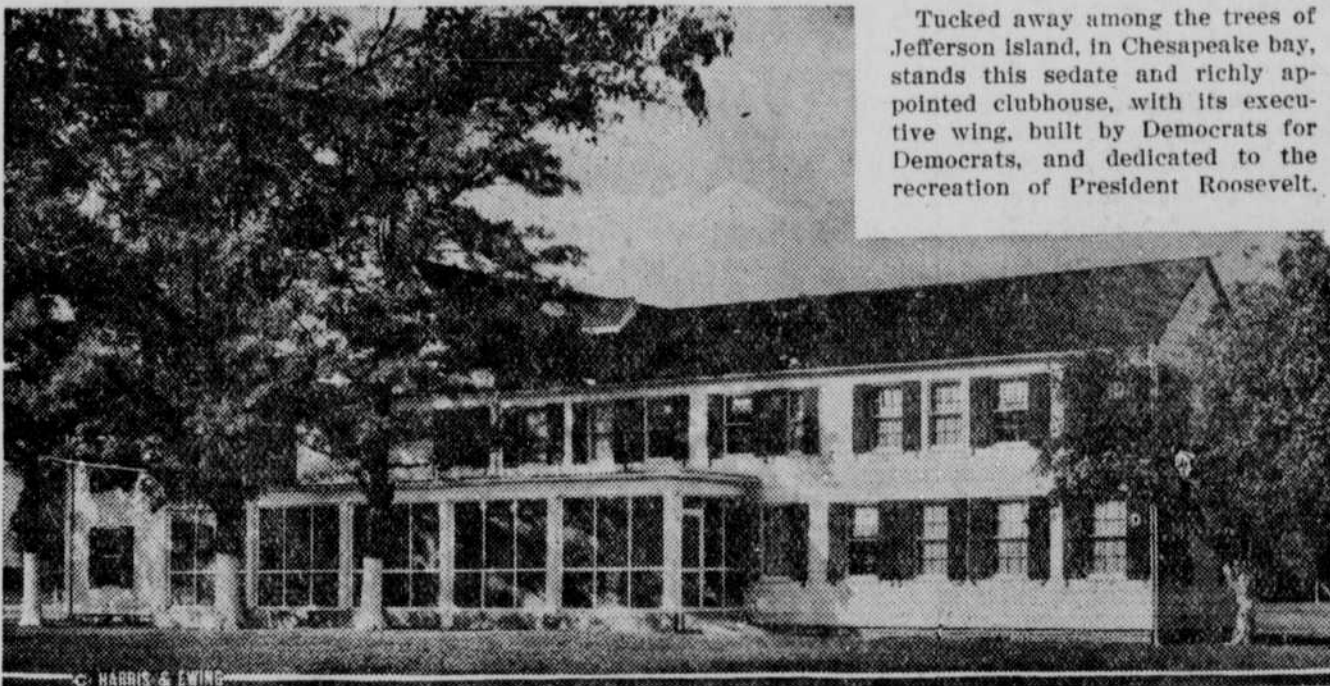


### Britain Launches Another Huge Submarine

### For Recreation of Eminent Democrats



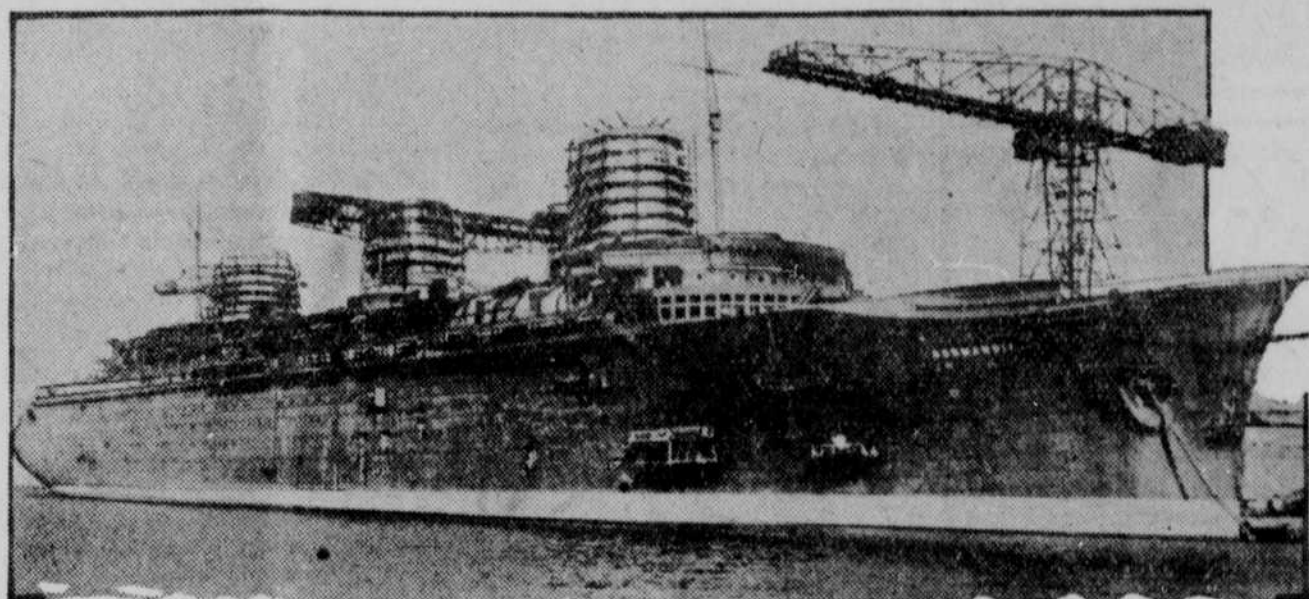

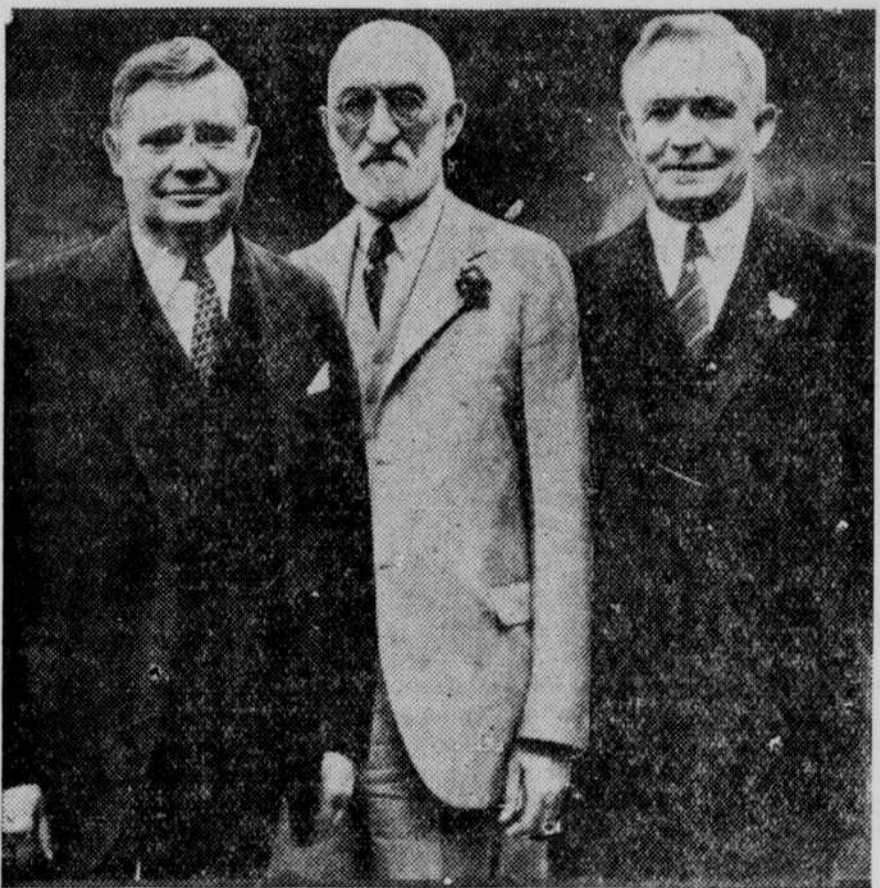

### Women of Oberammergau

The women of Oberammergau wear long, full red, black or multi-colored skirts and bodices, with kerchiefs or embroidered scarfs around their necks, crossed in front. On their heads are round, wide-brimmed, shallow-crowned hats. The men wear short jackets, knee breeches and footless stockings with hob-nailed shoes. Both men and women wear the "Gemsepinzel" perched on their hats. "Gemsepinzel" is the tuft from the breast of a chamois buck that inhabits the nearby mountains.

### First in Back to the Land Movement



Ernest Jeffers was the first city dweller to sign an application for 50 acres of land at Pinehurst, N. J. Hundreds applied for the land to live on and to till, as part of the back-to-the-farm movement. Most of the men are on relief in New York. They will clear the land themselves and make other applications to the housing administration to build their homes.

### Swallow Live Fishes

A practice among the natives of India and Siam of sticking the heads of live fishes in their mouths to hold them while using their hands to clean their nets, sometimes causes the death of the person involved through swallowing the fishes. Such accidents are included among 36 cases on record where fishes have been responsible for the deaths of men.

### Most Desolate Island

Navarino is perhaps the most southern permanent abode of man. This desolate island and a number of others, such as Hoste, Yendegala, Canakus and Lennox, all near Cape Horn, form the political district of Navarino, Chile's outpost of civilization. North of these islands flows Bengale channel, made famous by Darwin's studies and the voyage of the British ship Beagle.

### Venezuela's Torture System

Venezuela has an unusual torture for political prisoners. They are sent to the underground cells of Los Castillos prison where twice daily the tide comes rolling in up to their necks and they have to stand for hours to keep from drowning, writes Herbert Mueller. Glenn Elynn, III, in Collier's Weekly. After two or three days of this "tide treatment," they usually "change their minds" about the government and are released.

### Red Indians' Conception of a Supreme Being

The Indian Supreme Being had a number of different names: "He who gives us food," "He who is master of the earth," etc. Over a considerable part of the region, though not everywhere, he was also called Manitou, the common Algonkian word meaning supernatural being. Professor Cooper, anthropologist of the Catholic university of America, found that some of the Indians remembered his name as Kitci Manitou, or great spirit; but he is inclined to think that this title may have crept in since the coming of white men.

The Indians' Supreme Being was placed at the head of a highly developed organization of spirits by the eastern tribes, among whom Professor Cooper made his studies. He had under him four great "chief" spirits. Three ruled the birds, the four-footed animals and the fish, respectively. To the fourth was given the government of the caribou or wild reindeer, whose great importance to the Indians justified a separate rating.

Under each of the three "divisional chiefs" were many lesser overseer spirits, each having charge of a single species. Most important among the overseers of the birds were the rulers of the eagle and the fish hawk; chief among the overseers of mammals was the ruler of the bear. The Indians all agreed that these lesser spirits had not made their animals and did not own them; ownership was vested in the Supreme Being alone, and only he had the final decision over their disposal.
