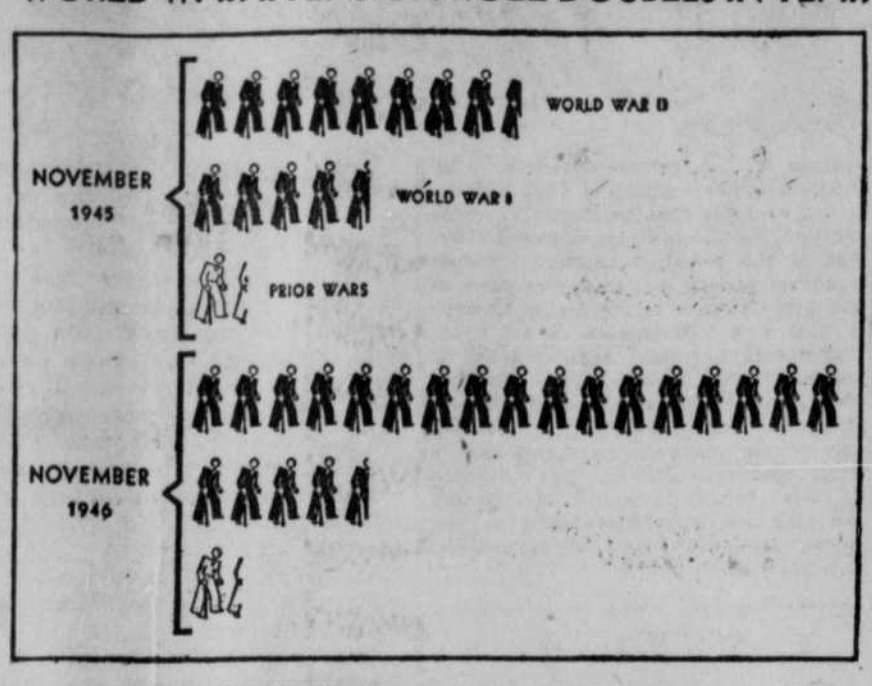

Health Chief Lauds Support of Seal Sale

"The seal sale is over. Nebraska has done a fine piece of work in assuring continued state activity toward the elimination of tuberculosis," according to Dr. W. S. Petty, of Lincoln, director of the state department of health. "The job to be done in Nebraska and in the country calls for a continuation of the kind of public financial support that has carried on, through voluntary gifts, in the Christmas seal sale for the past 39 years. Confidence, developed through accomplishment, helps substantially in presenting the picture to a generous public that has found the tuberculosis movement and knows where it is going in planning its program of work."
"No other public health work financed by voluntary contributions has such a fine history of results," Dr. Petty points out. "Nationwide, it still gets right

It is vital, that veterans include their "N" or "V" numbers when remitting premium payments. The "N" number is found on the veteran's yellow insurance certificate. When a veteran converts his wartime term insurance to a permanent type of NSLI insurance, a "V" number is issued.
