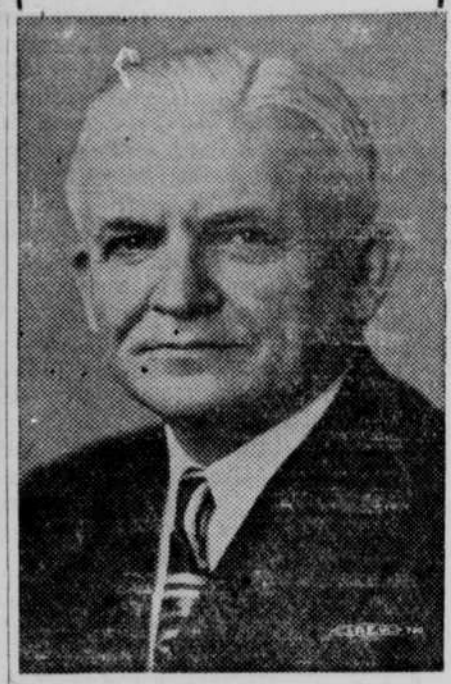
The Chambers fire department was called. No serious damage was done.
