NOTICE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC

We wish to call attention to Section of the Statute 36-716 R S. Nebr., 1943:

"Any person who shall deposit any kind of material or any part of a lawful road in this state inside or outside of the ditches, or cause the accumulation of rubbish or any kind of obstruction shall upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum not exceeding \$100.00, or shall be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than 30 days.

It has been called to our attention that telephone line repairmen and other individuals in various parts of the County are violating the above Section of the Law. We take this means of informing the Public that the accumulation of rubbish of any kind cannot be permitted in road ditches and sufficient time will be given for the removal of it. If it is not removed in a reasonable length of time it will be necessary to take legal action against the offending parties.

25 YEARS AGO  
July 12, 1923

Children at play along the Elkhorn river on the Strong ranch, west of Emmet, Friday found a skull and portions of the scalp with long black hair and an ear attached. A badly corroded ear ring of coiled copper wire was still attached to the ear.

Further investigation by the authorities, located a grave in the bank of the river, which had been exposed by recent high waters. A copper finger ring was found on one of the finger bones in the grave.
