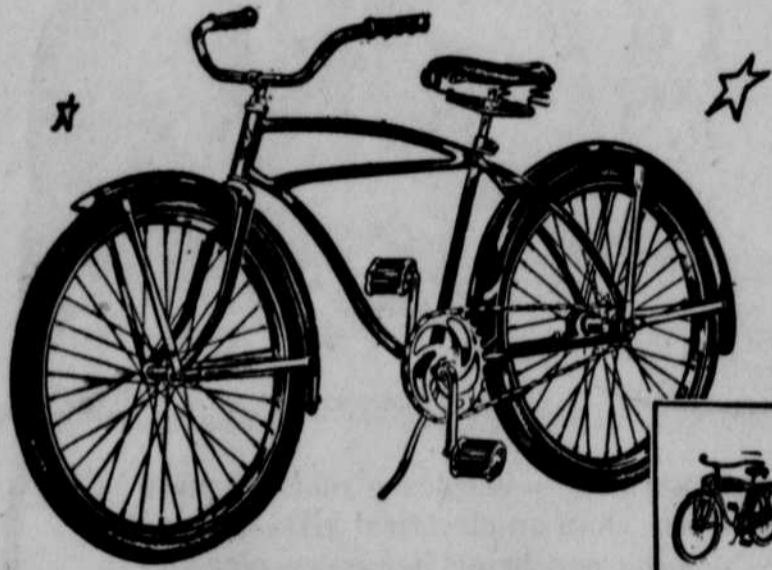
### School Reopens—
