Livestock Judging

All livestock will be judged and placed according to the Danish system, which is blue, ribbon, red ribbon and white ribbon groups. In addition a purple ribbon group will be selected from the blue awards in each class if the judge feels the show warrants. No purple awards may receive over \$5.00 and a maximum of \$15.00 is set up for a purple ribbon group. This system will carry through in all 4-H livestock classes.

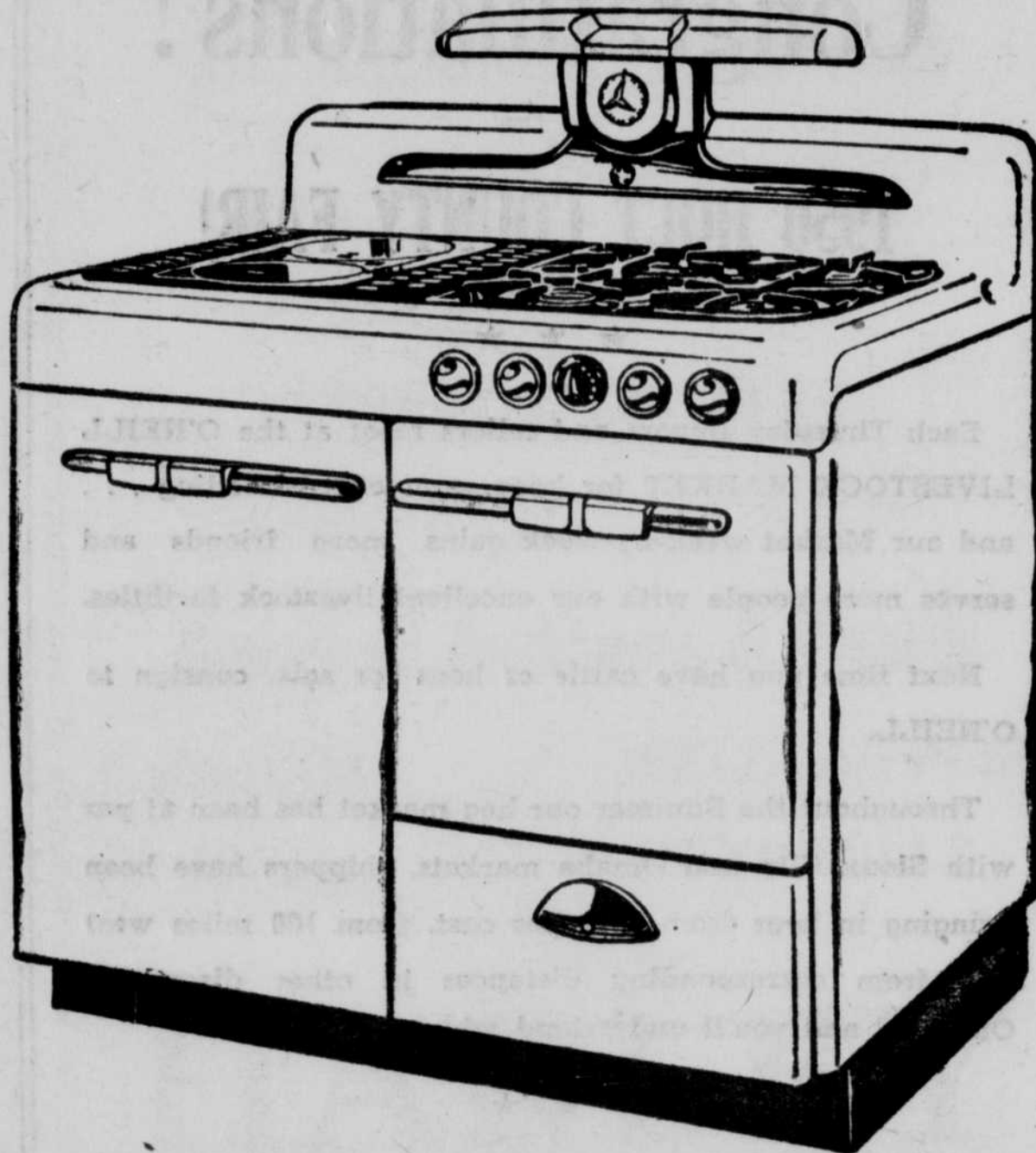
