The opinion of the judges is final in all cases, and judgment will be determined on general appearance, beauty of design, workmanship and suitability. In case of a tie duplicate prizes will be awarded.


5. A contestant may submit as many entries in the Nationwide Crochet Contest as have fulfilled ALL the foregoing rules.


