Weekly Market Report
of
The Atkinson Livestock Market
Atkinson, Nebraska

The uncertainty of weather and road conditions was primarily responsible for a lighter run of cattle here this week. We sold 1,170 cattle which included the 32 Registered Hereford Bulls of Joe Fitzgerald's.

Prices on most classes were generally steady with any noticeable decline in price due mainly to the seasonal decline in the quality of cattle offered. Weather and hazardous road conditions also contributed to the decline.

Choice steer calves sold from \$18.00 to \$20.00 with the top on a load of fancy calves at \$21.75 cwt. Heifer calves brought 14.00 to 16.50. Choice yearling steers were scarce and we didn't have any loads to compare with the last week's offering, this week they sold mainly from 18.75 down. There were no loads of yearling heifers, but prices ranged from 13.00 to 15.00 on the packages. Two loads of heavy cattle weighing 1225 and 1125 lbs. brought 18.00 and 16.30 cwt., respectively.

Canner cows sold from 7.00 to 8.00, cutters 8.00 to 9.00. Beef cows 9.00 to 10.50. The breeding cows sold from \$90.00 to \$126.00 per head. Butcher bulls brought 8.50 to 10.00.

The Registered Hereford Bulls made an average of \$260.00 per head on the 32 lots. Inquiry remains high on Stockers and Feeders, so if you have any cattle to sell before Jan. 1st, remember there are only 3 sales left in '53.
