With the full limit of 2,500 calves offered Monday, all classes sold on an active market which reflected fully 50 to 75 cents per hundred higher prices on heifer calves while most classes of steers sold steady to slightly lower than last week. Choice steers \$21.50 to \$23.00. Good kinds \$19.50 to \$21.25. Better grades of heiters went from \$17.75 to \$19.00. Plainer kinds from \$16.00 to

\$17.75 cwt. Tuesday's Auction included an overflow offering of 1,016 calves. Yearling steers sold from \$17.00 to \$18.35 while plainer kinds were taken from \$16.50 and down. One load of 2-yr.-old steers went at \$16.60 cwt. Yearling heifers mostly \$15.00 to \$16.25 for the pest kinds with crossbred and package kinds from \$14.75 and
