Monday & Tuesday Auctions

November 7 & 8

Cattle receipts 4,276 head. With the full limit of 2,500 calves offered Monday, all classes sold on an active market which reflected fully 50 to 75 cents per hundred higher prices on heifer calves while most classes of steers sold steady to slightly lower than last week. Choice steers \$21.50 to \$23.00. Good choices \$19.50 to \$21.25. Better grades of heifers went from \$17.75 to \$19.00. Plainier kinds from \$16.00 to \$17.75 cwt.

Tuesday's Auction included an overflow offering of 1,016 calves. Yearling steers sold from \$17.00 to \$18.35 while plainier kinds were taken from \$16.50 and down. One load of 2-yr.-old steers went at \$16.00 cwt. Yearling heifers mostly \$15.00 to \$16.25 for the best kinds with crossbred and pack-age kinds from \$14.75 and down.

Butcher cattle continued under pressure with cows fully 50c to \$1.00 lower with most of the decline on lower grades. Best beef cows \$8.00 to \$9.25, cutters \$7.00 to \$8.00, canners \$5.50 to \$6.75, bulls \$8.00 to \$10.50 cwt.
