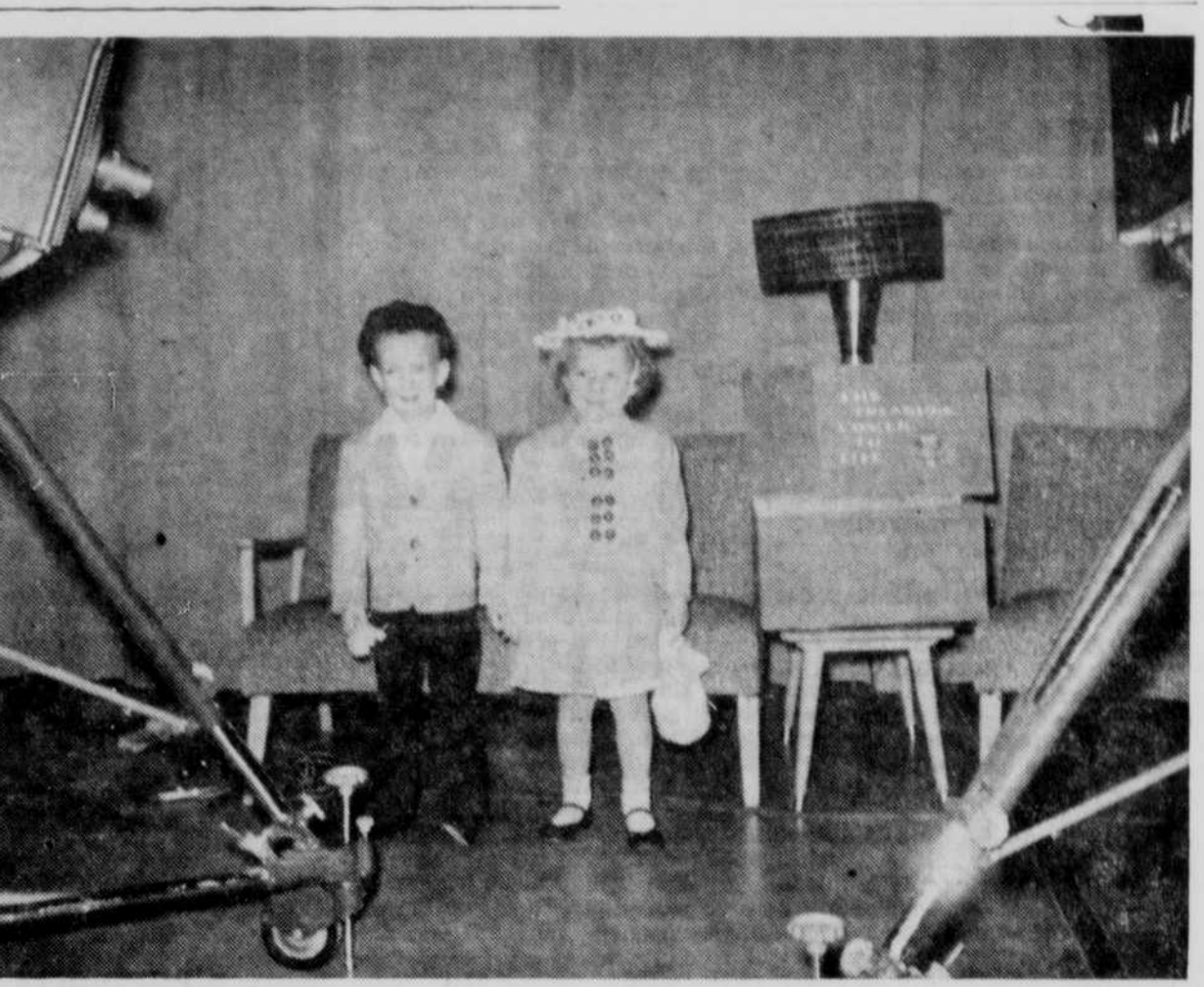
Club Meets in Park
