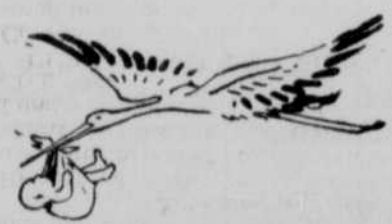




### Catch Up on Hometown News
