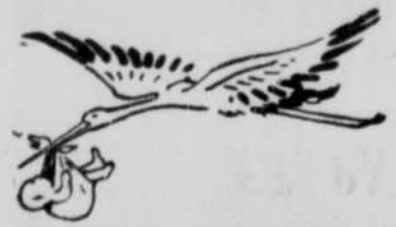

"The Old Reliable"

Tuesday, March 11, 1958 With a light offering on hand buyers pushed prices 50 to 1.00 per hundred higher than last week's auction on light weight offerings. Steer calves largely \$29.00 to \$33.00 cwt. with high choice kinds eligible higher, heifer calves \$25.00 to \$27.85 cwt. with no fancy kinds on offer. Yearling steers and heifers were from \$22.00 to \$24.00 cwt. on heifers. Demand continuing strong on all classes of butcher cattle.

Hog receipts were again above normal expectations, with the top on butchers at \$21.10 with practically all butchers at from \$20.40 to \$21.00 cwt. Sows 300 to 450 lbs. \$17.25 to \$19.00 cwt. Feeder at weights from 80 to 125 lbs \$22.75 to \$23.30 cwt.
