There should be 1,400-1,600 head of cattle today (Thursday) at our regular weekly sale.

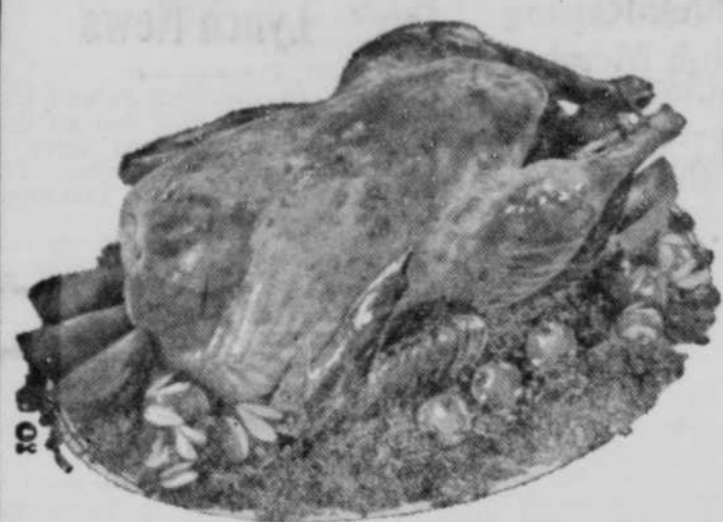
This run will include 700-900 calves, mostly Herefords. There will be about 500 yearlings, possibly up to 600 head.
