**Salmon Cheese Bake**  
Makes Good Lenten Dish Suggests Joe Sivesind

Midway in the Lenten season, most of you undoubtedly are ready for some well-flavored, easily prepared fish entrees. If so, here's an unusual main dish recommended by Joe Sivesind, local salesman of the Meadow Gold Dairy that features canned salmon. It also contains cottage cheese as an extra protein dividend.

Beatrice Cooke, director of the plant's main test kitchens in Chicago developed this delightfully different salmon asparagus cheese bake recipe.

Salmon Asparagus Cheese Bake (Four to six servings)  
1 lb. can salmon, drained and boned  
1 10-ounce package frozen cut-up asparagus, partially cooked  
2 tablespoons butter  
1 small onion, chopped  
1/4 cup chopped green pepper  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/2 teaspoon pepper  
1 10 1/2 oz. can condensed mushroom soup  
1 1/4 cups cottage cheese  
Chow Mein noodles  
Cook onion and green pepper in butter until tender; about 5 minutes. Stir in seasonings, mushroom soup and cottage cheese. Simmer for 10 minutes. In buttered individual casseroles or 1 1/2 quart casserole, alternate layers of salmon, asparagus and mushroom sauce. Top with chow mein noodles. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes.
