O'Neill—Gary W. Holly, radio man 3/c, USN, son of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley N. Holly of O'Neill and a 1938 graduate of St. Mary's Academy is serving on the staff of commander, U. S. Seventh Fleet aboard the heavy cruiser USS Saint Paul in the Far East. During July he toured the demilitarized zone at Panmanjom,

Korea, traveling by bus from Incheon, where the cruiser was anchored, to the capital city of Seoul enroute to Panmanjom.

His one hour tour included briefings on the military Armistice Commission meetings and stops in several of the buildings within the neutral circle, which is 88 yards in diameter, used by both the

United Nations personnel and members of the communist Korean Peoples Army.

U.S. Navy men are required to obtain permission from the communist side and the communist tour groups had to have permission from the UN command before they could enter the neutral zone.

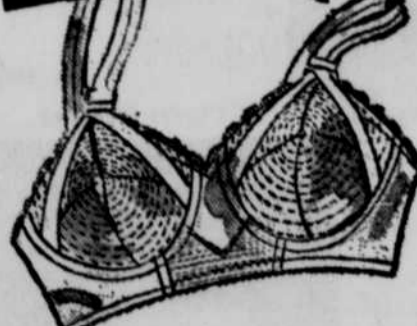
